Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mr. Seibert is requesting a renewal of a reporting modification that exempts him from disclosing the business and other governmental customers that paid \$10,000 or more during 2012 to Tootsie Roll Industries, Inc. (Tootsie Roll). • Mr. Seibert is a Director of Tootsie Roll. He stated that neither he nor his spouse had an ownership interest of 10% or more in the company during 2012. He said he is not involved in day-to-day operations of the company and does not have direct access to customer information. • Mr. Seibert stated that Tootsie Roll is an international company engaged in the manufacture and sale of confectionary products (such as Tootsie Rolls, Mason Dots, Junior Mints, etc.) to approximately 15,000 retailers & distributors in the United States and foreign countries. The company had annual sales of approximately \$500 million in 2012. • Mr. Seibert indicated that compiling the customer information would be a hardship on the company. He also stated that the candy industry is highly competitive and that Tootsie Roll considers its customer lists to be proprietary in nature.

Other Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mr. Seibert provided the name of one business customer in his request letter, Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. which he said was disclosed in a filing with the SEC as being in excess of 20% of sales.• Mr. Seibert stated that Tootsie Roll Industries, Inc. does no business with the City of Clyde Hill, and made no payments to them in 2012.

I am attaching a copy of the Application Questionnaire for 2012 provided to me in an email dated January 9, 2013 from Lori Anderson for a reporting modification for an F-1 Filing. This letter contains responses to each of the questions contained in this Application Questionnaire.

Response to Question #1. Modification Request Summary

A completed copy of the full F-1 Report is enclosed and is submitted to comply with the 2012 filing requirement. The request for a reporting modification relates to information required in the F-1 Supplement associated with my position as a director of Tootsie Roll Industries, Inc (see Part A, Entity #2). The F-1 Supplement instructs me to supply a list of "Business Customers and Other Government Agencies" from whom Tootsie Roll received payments in excess of \$10,000 (i.e., a list of customers). I am requesting that this requirement be modified.

Response to Question #2. Unreasonable Hardship

Tootsie Roll is an international company engaged in the manufacture and sale of confectionary products (including Tootsie Roll, Mason Dots, Junior Mint, Andes, Charleston Chew, Sugar Daddy) to approximately 15,000 retailers and distributors in the United States and foreign countries. Annual sales are approximately \$500 million. The candy industry is highly competitive and a list of its customers is considered proprietary information. The Company's website address is www.tootsie.com.

As a member of the Board of Directors, I do not have any involvement in the day-to-day operations of Tootsie Roll or direct access to its customer information. The only public disclosure of information about customers of Tootsie Roll is included in Form 10-K submitted to the Securities and Exchange Commission where it is indicated that in excess of 20% of sales are to Wal-Mart Stores, Inc.

Neither I, nor my spouse, either alone or in aggregate, have an ownership interest of 10% or more in Tootsie Roll Industries, Inc.

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Response to Question #3. Not Frustrate the Purposes of the Act

The City of Clyde Hill is a small residential community with only two small commercial establishments – a coffee shop and a gas station. There is no potential for a conflict of interest, either actual or perceived.

Response to Question #4. Duties

I am a council member of the City of Clyde Hill. My responsibilities include approving ordinances, contracts, the annual budget and establishing policies.

Response to Question #5. Customers or Sources of Compensation/Income

I am a board member of Tootsie Roll Industries, Inc. Primary responsibilities include representing shareholders, long-term strategy, management succession, executive compensation, monitoring financial performance, approval of capital budget and ensuring ethical behavior within the company.

Please also see my response to question #3.

Response to Question #6. Residential Address

An exemption from disclosing the address of my personal residence is not being requested.

Response to Question #7. Spousal Separation

An exemption from disclosing information related to my spouse is not being requested.

Response to Question #8. Other Information

I request that:

- I not be required to supply a list of Tootsie Roll's customers and
- the attached F-1 be accepted as presented to comply with reporting requirements for calendar year 2012.

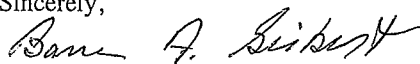
The requested modification will not in any way frustrate the goals of the Public Disclosure Commission. As noted above, there is no potential for a conflict of interest, either actual or perceived. Requiring disclosure of a customer list is an unreasonable hardship, particularly in this situation due to the highly competitive nature of the candy industry.

This request is the same as a request submitted in 2012 for calendar year 2011. Thank you for your consideration of this matter.

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Application Questionnaire Instructions

The purpose of the Public Disclosure Act in chapter RCW 42.17 includes at RCW 42.17.010(3):

“That the people shall be assured that the private financial dealings of their public officials, and of candidates for those offices, present no conflict of interest between the public trust and private interest.”

The form for providing disclosures of financial affairs is the F-1 Personal Financial Affairs Statement. The Act also provides for a process to seek a modification or suspension of reporting some information. RCW 42.17.370(10) states in part:

*“After hearing, by order approved and ratified by a majority of the membership of the commission, [the commission is empowered to] suspend or modify any of the reporting requirements of this chapter in a particular case if it finds that literal application of this chapter works a **manifestly unreasonable hardship** and if it also finds that the suspension or modification will not **frustrate the purposes of the chapter...***

... Any suspension or modification shall be only to the extent necessary to substantially relieve the hardship. The commission shall act to suspend or modify any reporting requirements only if it determines that facts exist that are clear and convincing proof of the findings required under this section.” (Emphasis added).

Possible qualifications for modifications or suspensions (referred to collectively as “modifications”) are found at RCW 42.17.370(10) and WAC 390-28-100. Copies of these provisions and reporting requirements are on the PDC’s website at www.pdc.wa.gov under “Laws and Rules.” The *Personal Financial Affairs Statement Instruction Manual* is also available on the website, under “Filer Resources – Manuals and Brochures.” The Commission has also adopted Interpretations addressing modifications for certain professions and situations, and those are also available under “Laws and Rules” then “Interpretations.” Modifications, if granted by the Commission, cover only one reporting period. Another application must be made in the following years if you still need a modification.

PDC staff has implemented this application procedure for filers requesting an F-1 Reporting Modification from the Commission. This is designed to provide more uniform information to the Commission from filers seeking a modification, and to enable a quicker response to possible questions about a request from the Commission at the hearing. **Please fill out this Application Questionnaire prior to having a modification request taken to the full Commission for consideration.** The blanks in this document will expand to accommodate your answers. **It is suggested that you review this entire Application Questionnaire first, before filling out your answers.**

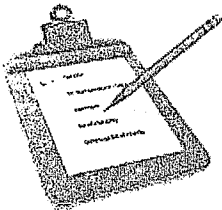

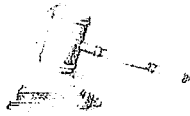

On March 22, 2012, the application of Barre Seibert, 2518 85th Avenue Northeast, Clyde Hill, Washington 98004, for a modification of the reporting requirements of RCW 42.17.241¹ was brought before the Public Disclosure Commission.

Consideration of the request was made pursuant to RCW 42.17A.120² and chapter 390-28 WAC by the Commission. The proceedings were held in Room 206, Evergreen Plaza Building, 711 Capitol Way, Olympia, Washington, 98504. The applicant, Barre Seibert, by letter and Modification Application, requested a renewal of the reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business and other governmental customers that paid \$10,000 or more during 2011 to Tootsie Roll Industries, Inc. (Tootsie Roll).

The Commission was provided with a certification from Mr. Seibert waiving his personal appearance at the hearing and stating that the facts contained in the request are true and accurate.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Based upon the letter and Modification Application, the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact:

1. Mr. Seibert has previously been granted the requested reporting modification, the most recent being Order No. 2974.
2. Mr. Seibert is an elected Clyde Hill City Council member. His current term of office expires in December 2015.
3. Mr. Seibert is a Director of Tootsie Roll. He stated that neither he nor his spouse had an ownership interest of 10% or more in the company during 2011. He said he is not involved in day-to-day operations of the company and does not have direct access to customer information.
4. Mr. Seibert stated that Tootsie Roll is an international company engaged in the manufacture and sale of confectionary products (such as Tootsie Rolls, Mason Dots, Junior

Mints, etc.) to approximately 15,000 retailers and distributors in the United States and foreign countries. The company had annual sales of approximately \$500 million in 2011.

5. Mr. Seibert indicated that compiling the customer information would be a hardship on the company. He also stated that the candy industry is highly competitive and that Tootsie Roll considers its customer lists to be proprietary in nature.
6. Mr. Seibert provided the name of one business customer in his request letter, Wal-Mart Stores, Inc., which he said was disclosed as a customer in a filing with the SEC as being in excess of 20% of sales.
7. Mr. Seibert stated that Tootsie Roll Industries, Inc. does no business with the City of Clyde Hill, and made no payments to the city in 2011.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Having made these Findings of Fact, the Commission makes the following Conclusions of Law:

1. Literal compliance with all the provisions of the reporting requirements of RCW 42.17.241³ would work a manifestly unreasonable hardship on the applicant.
2. Limited suspension or modification of the reporting requirements as specified in the Order would not frustrate the purposes of the Act in this particular case.

ORDER

Having made these Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Commission issues the following Order:

For the Statement of Financial Affairs required to be filed with the Public Disclosure Commission between January 1 and April 16, 2012:

1. The applicant may satisfy the requirements of RCW 42.17.241(1)(g)(ii)³ without identifying the reportable business and other governmental customers of Tootsie Roll Industries, Inc.
2. In all other matters required to be reported, the applicant shall comply in full with the reporting requirements of RCW 42.17/42.17A.
