Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<p><u>Ecova</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ms. Blake is requesting renewal of a reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing the business customers that paid \$10,000 or more during 2013 to Ecova. • Ms. Blake is a director of Ecova, a provider of energy efficiency and cost management programs and services for multi-site customers and utilities throughout North America. Its primary product lines include expense management services for utility, telecom, and lease needs as well as strategic energy management and efficiency services that include procurement, conservation, performance reporting, financial planning, and energy efficiency program management for commercial enterprises and utilities. • For 2013, Ecova had annual sales revenues of \$177.8 million, with 751 customers and 1,456 employees. Of these customers, 658 paid the entity over \$10,000 in 2013. • Ms. Blake said she is not involved in the day-to-day operations of the business and does not have access to information about the entity's customers. • Ms. Blake stated that disclosing the business customers of Ecova would adversely affect the competitive position of the company and in many cases their customer agreements preclude them from disclosing their relationship. She also stated that it is an unreasonable hardship to her because Ecova is unwilling to provide the information to her.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Ms. Blake stated that as a board member, she does not deal with individual customer accounts. She said that the reporting requirements do not relate to a business customer that would be subject to the regulatory authority of her appointed position.
Other Issues	<p>Ms. Blake stated that the University of Washington did not conduct any business with and made no payments to Ecova during 2013</p> <p>Ms. Blake is no longer requesting a modification for Laird Norton Wealth Management having resigned her position effective December 31, 2012.</p>
Staff Recommendations	Approve renewal of the reporting modification with minor change.
