Explanation of Rule(s)	Applicants whose spouse or registered domestic partner creates a reporting obligation for the applicant. When an applicant is required to report the activities of an entity solely because the applicant's spouse or registered domestic partner held an office, directorship, general partnership or ownership interest in the entity and the applicant does not have direct knowledge of the information that must be reported, the applicant may be allowed to satisfy the disclosure requirements of RCW 42.17A.710 (1)(g)(ii) and WAC 390-24-020 by disclosing reportable customers from whom compensation in excess of the disclosure threshold established under RCW 42.17A.710 (1)(g)(ii) has been received as follows: (A) All payments made by the agency or jurisdiction in which the applicant seeks or holds office to the entity; (B) The business and other governmental customers or clients of the applicant's spouse/domestic partner and of the entity of which the applicant is aware; and (C) Any other business and other governmental customers or clients of the entity whose identities are known to the applicant and whose interests are significantly affected by the agency or jurisdiction in which the applicant seeks or holds office. Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 F. Lorraine Bodi is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt them from disclosing the business customers that paid \$12,000, during the previous twelve months, to Eglick & Whited, PLLC (E & W Law), a small law firm with two partners and two paralegals. Bodi's spouse, Peter Jay Eglick, is a partner with 50% ownership interest.

- Bodi stated that they have no personal knowledge of the firm's clients or finances nor do they have access to the firm's client list or to any other firm data. The applicant stated that they have no involvement in the day-to-day operations or legal work of the firm and has only seen the bottom-line income on the firm's tax return.
 The applicant has been told that the annual billings of the firm fluctuate in the
 - The applicant has been told that the annual billings of the firm fluctuate in the range of approximately \$800,000 up to \$1 million and that virtually all of the firm's clients would be reportable.
 - F. Lorraine Bodi stated that disclosing the reportable clients of E & W Law would create a competitive disadvantage and reveal confidential business information that could be harmful.
 - Bodi stated that none of the firm's clients are listed in Martindale Hubbell and the firm's website does not include a current list of the firm's clients.

Other Issues

F. Lorraine Bodi reported that the City of Lake Forest Park made no payments to E & W Law during the previous twelve months.

The applicant has agreed to recuse themselves if a matter came before them involving a conflict of interest between E & W Law and the duties, if elected, as a City Council Member of the City of Lake Forest Park.

Bodi's spouse has agreed to refrain from receiving payments from clients concerning Lake Forest Park matters.
