<b>Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mr. Dammeier is requesting renewal of a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$10,000 or more during 2013 to Valley Press d.b.a. Print NW.</li> <li>• Print NW is a commercial printing business in Washington. Mr. Dammeier stated that, in 2012, Print NW had annual sales of \$15.9 million, with 858 accounts, and 130 employees. He said that 176 business customers would be subject to disclosure.</li> <li>• Mr. Dammeier is a minority owner/partner of Print NW, he owns a 14% interest. He stated that he is not involved in the day-to-day operations and does not have direct access to customer lists. He said his role is strategic in nature and largely carried out through his participation in quarterly board meetings at which board members review performance and plan for the future of the company.</li> <li>• Mr. Dammeier stated that disclosing the business customers will create a competitive disadvantage for Print NW, since the printing business is a highly competitive industry.</li> </ul>
<b>Other Issues</b>	Mr. Dammeier disclosed the other governmental customers that paid \$10,000 or more to Print NW in 2013.
<b>Staff Recommendations</b>	Approve renewal of the reporting modification with no change.
