Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<p><u>Personal Residential Address</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Judge Chun is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing his personal residential address information, including street address, parcel number, or legal description, on his Personal Financial Affairs Statement covering the last 12 months. • Judge Chun stated that for safety and security concerns he has been advised not to disclose his personal residential address information. • Judge Chun stated that he has and will take steps to block his residence from appearing on common search websites. <p><u>Summit Law Group, PLLC</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Judge Chun is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the reportable business customers of the law firm, Summit Law Group, PLLC, that paid \$10,000 or more during the last 12 months, of which he was a member. • Judge Chun stated that Summit Law Group, PLLC, is law firm located in Seattle, Spokane and the Tri-Cities with 37 total lawyers. • Judge Chun said he does not have access to the client base or compensation information of Summit Law Group, PLLC.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Judge Chun stated that, upon his request, Summit Law Group, PLLC refused him information about the firm's business customers citing concerns about competitive disadvantage and confidentiality.• Judge Chun also stated that Summit Law Group, PLLC, expressed concerns about his trying to identify customers for whom he worked directly, citing concerns about potential inaccuracy of the information.
Other Issues	Judge Chun disclosed creditor information, payment terms, security given and mortgage amounts for his personal residence.
