#### Allegations for which Respondent and Staff Are Stipulating to Violations

Citizens for Two-Thirds is a political committee formed to support Proposition 1, a ballot proposition in the November 5, 2013 general election in the City of Yakima. This case involves violations of RCW 42.17A.205, .235, and .240, and WAC 390-16-125 during the 2013 election for exceeding the limits of the Mini Reporting option prior to submitting a complete application to change reporting options.

Staff is providing you a Stipulation as to Facts, Violations and Penalty for your consideration that staff and the Respondent believe accurately describes the nature of the violations, the relevant facts, and an appropriate penalty. We are also providing a document showing comparable cases. We will be asking the Commission to accept the Stipulation.

#### Respondent's Request for Suspension or Modification of Reporting Requirements

WAC 390-16-125(1) requires that an application to change reporting options be submitted *before* the applicant exceeds the limits of the Mini Reporting option. The Committee did not do so in this instance, but would nevertheless like to change reporting options. In previous situations, staff has processed and approved similar requests when the applicant has been able to "return" to compliance with the Mini Reporting limits before submitting the completed application (for example, by returning over-limit contributions). In this situation, however, it is not possible for the committee to "return" to compliance, so in addition to stipulating to a violation and penalty for exceeding the Mini Reporting limits prior to receiving staff's approval for a change in reporting options, Citizens for Two-Thirds is requesting that the Commission suspend or modify WAC 390-16-125(1) to allow PDC staff to accept the Committee's complete application to change reporting options *after* the Mini Reporting limits were exceeded. Given the unique circumstances of the application, which Citizens for Two-Thirds describes more fully in its request, PDC staff supports the Committee's request to the Commission.

# Enforcement

The parties to this Stipulation, namely, the Public Disclosure Commission Staff, through its Executive Director, Andrea McNamara Doyle, and Respondent Citizens for Two-Thirds, through its attorney, Dan Brady, submit this Stipulation as to Facts, Violations and Penalty in this matter. The parties agree that the Commission has the authority to accept, reject or modify the terms of this Stipulation. The parties further agree that in the event that the Commission suggests modification to any term of this agreement, each party reserves the right to reject that modification. In the event either party rejects a modification, this matter will proceed to hearing before the Commission.

#### **JURISDICTION**

The Public Disclosure Commission has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to RCW 42.17A, the Public Disclosure Act; RCW 34.05, the Administrative Procedure Act; and WAC 390.

#### **FACTS**

- Respondent Citizens for Two-Thirds is a political committee formed to support Proposition

   a ballot proposition in the November 5, 2013 general election in the City of Yakima.

   Proposition 1 would amend the Yakima City Charter to require the affirmative vote of at least five city council members to assess, levy or increase any tax in the city.
- 2. Citizens for Two-Thirds registered with the Public Disclosure Commission by filing a Political Committee Registration (C-1pc Report) on April 30, 2013. The report indicated the committee's choice of the Mini Reporting option, which limited the committee to \$5,000 in

- aggregate contributions and expenditures, and \$500 in aggregate contributions from any one source for the duration of the Proposition 1 campaign.
- 3. On May 29, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds contacted the Public Disclosure Commission for assistance with changing from Mini-Reporting to full, Regular Reporting. The Committee began this process of its own volition and not as a result of a PDC query, investigation, or third party complaint.
- 4. On June 12, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds submitted an amended C-1pc report and Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 Reports) and Campaign Summary Receipts and Expenditures reports (C-4 Reports) as part of an application to change to the Full Reporting option. In submitting this application, Citizens for Two-Thirds stated that it was aware of no political committee established to oppose Proposition 1.
- 5. The reports submitted on June 12, 2013 indicated that Citizens for Two-Thirds had accepted contributions from Yakima Valley Publishing and Ben Shoval that exceeded the \$500 limit of the Mini Reporting option on contributions from one source.
- 6. The reports submitted on June 12, 2013 indicated that Citizens for Two-Thirds had raised \$5,930 and spent \$5,227, exceeding the \$5,000 limit of the Mini Reporting option on aggregate contributions and expenditures. The expenditure totals did not include outstanding obligations for signature gathering services.
- 7. On July 9, 2013, in an attempt to return to compliance with the Mini Reporting limits, Citizens for Two-Thirds submitted reports indicating that from June 12 to June 30, 2013, the committee refunded certain contributions and obtained refunds from Evergreen Petition Management, LLC for payments made for signature gathering services. However, because Evergreen Petition Management, LLC had already performed the signature gathering services, the payments refunded to Citizens for Two-Thirds are now obligations owed to Evergreen Petition Management, LLC, subject to the \$5,000 expenditure limit under the Mini Reporting option.

- 8. As of August 12, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds had received \$4,960 in cash and in-kind contributions and had made \$877 in expenditures (cash and in-kind). In addition, Citizens for Two-Thirds had outstanding obligations of \$14,974, making total campaign expenditures \$15,851<sup>1</sup>.
- 9. On July 18, 2013, PDC staff notified Citizens for Two-Thirds in writing that because the committee exceeded the limits of the Mini Reporting option prior to applying for a change in reporting options, PDC staff was unable to process or approve the application to change to the Full Reporting option.
- 10. Citizens for Two-Thirds has returned all monetary contributions exceeding \$500 in the aggregate from one source. In addition, Citizens for Two Thirds has made no additional expenditures, beyond incurring obligations for legal counsel and professional compliance services necessary to resolve this complaint.

#### STATUTORY AND RULE AUTHORITY

- 14. RCW 42.17A.205 states, in part: "(1) Every political committee, within two weeks after its organization or, within two weeks after the date when it first has the expectation of receiving contributions or making expenditures in any election campaign, whichever is earlier, shall file a statement of organization with the commission." ... and "(3) Any material change in information previously submitted in a statement of organization shall be reported to the commission within the ten days following the change."
- 15. **RCW 42.17A.235 and .240** require political committees under the full reporting option to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures.
- 16. WAC 390-16-105(2) states, in part: "A political committee, as that term is defined in RCW 42.17A.005, shall not be required to comply with the provisions of RCW 42.17A.225 through 42.17A.240 except as otherwise prescribed in WAC 390-16-038, 390-16-115, and 390-16-125 when neither aggregate contributions nor aggregate expenditures exceed five

thousand dollars and no contribution or contributions from any person exceed five hundred dollars."

- 17. WAC 390-16-125 states, in part, "(1) A candidate or political committee shall apply in writing to the commission for authorization to change reporting options before the limitations specified in WAC 390-16-105 are exceeded. A complete application shall include all of the following documents:
  - (a) An amended registration statement (Form C-1 for candidates, Form C-1pc for political committees) selecting the full reporting option as provided in RCW 42.17A.225 - 42.17A.240;
  - (b) PDC forms C-3 and C-4 with relevant schedules and attachments disclosing all contributions and expenditures to date reportable under RCW 42.17A.240 for the election campaign, or in the case of continuing political committees, for the calendar year; and
  - (c) ...(ii) If the applicant is the treasurer of a political committee supporting or opposing a ballot proposition, a statement affirming that all treasurers of all political committees registered with the commission as supporting or opposing the proposition have been notified personally in writing of the application, and the manner and date of such notification."

...

(5) Exceeding the aggregate contributions or aggregate expenditures specified in WAC 390-16-105 without complying with the provisions of this section shall constitute one or more violations of chapter 42.17A RCW or 390-17 WAC."

#### **VIOLATION**

Based on the Stipulation of Facts set forth above, Respondent Citizens for Two Thirds stipulates that the committee violated RCW 42.17A.205, RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240, and WAC 390-16-125 by exceeding the Mini Reporting limits in WAC 390-16-105 without complying with the provisions of WAC 390-16-125.

#### **PENALTY**

Based upon the stipulated facts and violations set forth above, Respondent Citizens for Two-Thirds agrees to pay a total civil penalty of \$500.

Respondent affirms its intention to comply in good faith with the provisions of RCW 42.17A in the future.

#### **BACKGROUND**

- 1.1 Citizens for Two-Thirds is a political committee formed to support Proposition 1, a ballot proposition in the November 5, 2013 general election in the City of Yakima. If passed by voters, Proposition 1 would amend the Yakima City Charter to require the affirmative vote of at least five city council members to assess, levy or increase any tax in the city.
- 1.2 Citizens for Two-Thirds registered with the Public Disclosure Commission by filing a Political Committee Registration (C-1pc Report) on April 30, 2013. (Exhibit 1.) The registration listed Ben Shoval as Citizens for Two-Thirds' treasurer, and indicated the committee's choice of the Mini Reporting option, which limited the committee to \$5,000 in aggregate contributions and expenditures, and \$500 in aggregate contributions from any one source for the duration of the Proposition 1 campaign. By selecting the Mini Reporting option, Citizens for Two-Thirds was not required to file the ongoing reports of contributions and expenditures required of committees under the Full Reporting option.
- 1.3 On June 21, 2013, the Washington Public Disclosure Commission (PDC or Commission) received a complaint from Paul George alleging that Citizens for Two-Thirds violated the state's campaign disclosure and contribution laws. (Exhibit 2.)

1.4 On July 5, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds submitted sufficient qualifying signatures to place Proposition 1 on the ballot. Media reports indicated that these signatures were collected through a combination of paid workers and volunteers.

#### ALLEGATIONS IN COMPLAINT

2.1 Paul George's complaint alleged that Citizens for Two-Thirds violated RCW 42.17A.205, .235, and .240, and WAC 390-16-125 by exceeding the limits of the Mini Reporting option, and by failing to properly change to the Full Reporting option before exceeding the limits of the Mini Reporting option.

III.

#### **FINDINGS**

- 3.1 Application to Change Reporting Options: On June 12, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds submitted an amended C-1pc report, Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 Reports), and Campaign Summary Receipts and Expenditures reports (C-4 Reports) as part of an application to change to the Full Reporting option. The reports (Exhibit 3) indicated that the committee had accepted contributions that exceeded the \$500 limit of the Mini Reporting option on contributions from one source. As of May 30, 2013, Yakima Valley Publishing had provided in-kind contributions of advertising to the committee valued at \$2,305, including a full-page advertisement to reproduce the signature petition for the charter amendment. (Exhibit 4.) As of June 12, 2013, contributions (including loans) from the personal funds of Ben Shoval totaled \$3,000.
- 3.2 The reports submitted on June 12, 2013 indicated that as of that date, Citizens for Two-Thirds had raised \$5,930 and spent \$5,227, exceeding the \$5,000 limit of the Mini Reporting option on aggregate contributions and expenditures.
- 3.3 On June 18, 2013, PDC staff sent an email to Mr. Shoval, informing him that in order for Citizens for Two-Thirds' application to change reporting options to be processed or approved, it would be necessary for the committee to return to compliance with the Mini Reporting limits, for example by cancelling outstanding orders and obtaining refunds of vendor payments in order to bring the committee's total expenditures below \$5,000, and to free sufficient

cash to make refunds and payments to contributors who had contributed more than \$500 in the aggregate. (Exhibit 5.)

- 3.4 Attempt to Return to Compliance with Mini Limits: On July 9, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds submitted reports indicating that from June 12 30, 2013, the committee conducted refunds of certain contributions. (Exhibit 6.) However, during this period the committee also accepted and retained \$3,935 in new contributions, bringing the committee's aggregate contributions to \$6,865 and further exceeding the \$5,000 limit of the Mini Reporting option on aggregate contributions. The new contributions included \$5,000 accepted on June 17, 2013, and attributed jointly to Bruce and Ginger Smith, again exceeding the \$500 limit of the Mini Reporting option on contributions from one source. (Mr. Smith is a registered officer of Citizens for Two-Thirds.)
- 3.5 The reports that Citizens for Two-Thirds submitted on July 9, 2013 indicate that on June 12, 2013, the committee received a full refund of \$2,922 paid to Evergreen Petition Management, LLC between May 30, 2013 and June 7, 2013 for signature gathering services. However, in an email to PDC staff sent on July 17, 2013, Sharon Hanek, a CPA assisting the committee, stated that Evergreen Petition Management, LLC did perform services for Citizens for Two-Thirds, and expected payment from the committee, indicating that payments for signature gathering services could not properly be deducted from the committee's expenditure totals. (Exhibit 7.)
- 3.6 Ms. Hanek further stated that Citizens for Two-Thirds determined it would pay Yakima Valley Publishing for \$2,305 in advertising reported as an in-kind contribution on June 12, 2013. She stated that the committee had requested an invoice from the company. This promise to pay for the advertising added \$2,305 in expenditures to the committee's expenditure totals. Together with payments owed to Evergreen Petition Management, LLC and \$233 in additional expenditures, as of June 30, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds' aggregate expenditures stood at \$5,460, exceeding the \$5,000 limit of the Mini Reporting option on aggregate expenditures.
- 3.7 On July 18, 2013, PDC staff sent a letter to Citizens for Two-Thirds, notifying the committee that because it exceeded the limits of the Mini Reporting option prior to applying for a change in reporting options, PDC staff was unable to process or approve the committee's application to change to the Full Reporting option. (Exhibit 8.)
- 3.8 Response to Complaint / Additional Filings: On August 12, 2013, a response to the complaint filed by Paul George was received from Dan Brady, counsel to Citizens for Two-Thirds. (Exhibit 9.) In his response, Mr. Brady stated that when Citizens for Two-Thirds registered on April 30, 2013, the committee fully intended to operate completely within the limits of the Mini Reporting option. He stated that when the committee realized that the

contributions and expenditures required for professional signature gathering services would cause it to exceed the limits of the Mini Reporting option, on May 28, 2013, Ben Shoval left voicemails with PDC staff seeking guidance on how to transition to Full Reporting.

- 3.9 Mr. Brady stated that after receiving written guidance from PDC staff on June 3, 2013, the committee retained Sharon Hanek, an accountant who represented herself as familiar with PDC laws and rules, to guide the committee through the switch to Full Reporting, in addition to filing any PDC forms going forward. He stated that Ms. Hanek was confused by PDC staff's instruction that the committee could return contributions, cancel orders, and obtain refunds of expenses in order to return to compliance with the Mini Reporting limits. He stated that she did not understand that goods or services already received would remain expenditures, unpaid obligations, or in-kind contributions/expenses at the time they were ordered regardless of what the campaign bank account indicated. He stated that Ms. Hanek erroneously believed and maintained that as long as actual funds in the account were less than \$5,000, and the committee didn't make actual cash outlays exceeding \$5,000, Citizens for Two-Thirds was compliant with the Mini Reporting option.
- 3.10 Mr. Brady stated that during this period of confusion, payments for signature gathering and estimates for services not yet rendered were never reported. However, he stated that the committee's largest payments and obligations, including for advertising and signature gathering, were at least partially disclosed when Citizens for Two-Thirds filed its early request to change reporting options on June 12, 2013. He stated that the committee's full obligation for signature gathering services was disclosed in draft C-4 reports attached to his response.
- 3.11 Mr. Brady stated although Citizens for Two-Thirds had made expenditures in excess of the \$5,000 Mini Reporting limit, the committee had incurred less than \$200 in expenditures or other obligations since June 30, 2013, and none following the committee's receipt of PDC staff's July 18, 2013 letter informing the committee that its request to change to Full Reporting could not be processed or approved. He stated that the only exception were obligations for legal counsel and professional compliance services to resolve this complaint. He stated that the committee had received only one \$200 monetary contribution since June 30, 2013, and had refunded that contribution. He stated that the committee had refunded all contributions above \$500 from a single source.
- 3.12 The draft reports submitted with Mr. Brady's response to the complaint were submitted in a final, electronic form on August 20, 2013. (Exhibit 10.) The reports disclosed that as of July 31, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds had accepted and retained \$4,960 in monetary and in-kind contributions, and had incurred \$15,851 in aggregate expenditures, including \$877 in actual cash

payments and in-kind expenditures, and \$14,974 in unpaid obligations. **(Exhibit 10, pp 1 - 36.)** The reports included the following expenditures, disclosed for the first time:

3.13 The reports filed on August 20, 2013 disclosed that the only contribution and expenditure activity Citizens for Two-Thirds conducted after August 1, 2013 was to accept a \$500 in-kind contribution of legal services, and to incur \$1,500 in obligations for legal services, and \$500 in obligations for other compliance services. (Exhibit 10, pp 38 - 41.)

#### SCOPE

- 4.1 PDC staff reviewed the following documents:
  - 1. A complaint against Citizens for Two-Thirds, received from Paul George on June 21, 2013;

  - 3. An article published in the Yakima *Herald* on July 6, 2013, titled *"Two-Thirds tax increase measure makes Yakima ballot"*;
  - 4. PDC correspondence to Citizens for Two-Thirds, mailed on July 18, 2013;

- 5. A formal response to Mr. George's complaint, received from Dan Brady on August 12, 2013, including draft filings;
- 6. Additional email correspondence from Dan Brady, received on August 6, 2013; August 13, 2013, August 15, 2013, and August 16, 2013;
- 7. Email correspondence received from Ben Shoval on June 3, 2013; June 24, 2013; July 11, 2013; July 15, 2013; July 15, 2013; July 23, 2013; and July 26, 2013;
- 8. Email correspondence received from Sharon Hanek on June 28, 2013; July 17, 2013; and July 18, 2013;
- 9. Email correspondence received from Bruce Smith on August 7, 2013; August 11, 2013; and August 13, 2013;
- 10. Email correspondence received from Sonya Claar Tee, Yakima City Clerk, on August 14, 2013;
- 11. A C-1pc Political Committee Registration for Citizens for Two-Thirds, received on April 30, 2013;
- 12. An amended C-1pc registration for Citizens for Two-Thirds, received on June 12, 2013; and
- 13. C-3 and C-4 contribution and expenditure reports for Citizens for Two-Thirds, received on June 12, 2013; July 9, 2013; and August 20, 2013.

#### LAW

**RCW 42.17A.205** requires every political committee to file a statement of organization with the commission. The statement must be filed within two weeks after organization or within two weeks after the date the committee first has the expectation of receiving contributions or making expenditures in any election campaign, whichever is earlier.

**RCW 42.17.235 and .240** require political committees to file timely, accurate reports of monetary and in-kind contributions, including contributions pledged but not received, and monetary and in-kind expenditures, including debts, orders placed and obligations. The reports are filed monthly following an excess of \$200 in contribution or expenditure activity, except during the five months before the election, during which time summary reports of receipts and expenditures are required to be filed 21 days and again 7 days before each election in which the committee is participating. The reports must disclose any debt, obligation, note, unpaid loan, or other liability valued at more than \$250, or valued at more than \$50 that has been outstanding for over thirty days. Any contributions received and expenditures made prior to the date of registration must be disclosed on the day the registration is filed. Reports of contributions must include the name and address of any contributor who has given more than \$25 in the aggregate.

**WAC 390-16-105** exempts political committees from the requirement to comply with the C-3 and C-4 reporting requirements of RCW 42.17A.225 through 42.17A.240, when neither aggregate contributions nor aggregate expenditures exceed five thousand dollars and no contribution or contributions from any person exceed five hundred dollars.

**WAC 390-16-115** states, in part: "The exemptions allowed in WAC 390-16-105 shall be granted to a candidate or political committee ... only upon compliance with the following conditions. ... (2) A political committee shall, within fourteen days after its organization or after the date when it first has the expectation of receiving contributions or making expenditures in any election campaign, whichever is earlier, file the C1-pc registration statement with the commission. (3) The statement filed under subsection (2) of this section shall declare that the political committee will not exceed the contribution or expenditure limits set out in WAC 390-16-105."

**WAC 390-16-125** states that in order to be processed or approved, a complete application to change reporting options must be delivered to the PDC on or before thirty business days prior to the date of the election, and before a political committee exceeds the limits of the Mini Reporting option. The rule states that exceeding the Mini Reporting limits in WAC 390-16-105 without complying with the provisions of WAC 390-16-125 shall constitute one or more violations of the PDC's laws and rules.

I hereby complain that the above-named Committee is exceeding the mini reporting limits while registered under the mini reporting option that sets a \$5,000 limit on total campaign expenditures and places a \$500 cap on contributions from a single source.

I assert that the Two-Thirds Committee treasurer is required to regularly report campaign contributions and expenditures to the PDC.

This is based on the following provision in a PDC document of March 2013 - "Starting Off on the Right Foot" - that states:

"A political committee is exempt from reporting if its sole purpose is to support or oppose a local ballot measure in a town or district that had fewer than 1,000 registered voters as of the last general election."

Full disclosure strengthens the right of Yakima voters to know who is financing this initiative that would drastically change the City Charter by giving veto power over certain public business decisions to a minority of three of the seven elected council members thereby replacing majority rule established in July 1959 when Council-Manager governance took over City Hall after an overwhelming vote of the people.

According to City Hall, nearly 92,000 people reside within the corporate limits and according to the County Auditor's office 39,385 Yakima city residents were registered to vote in the last general election.

The Two-Thirds Committee states it has about 30 volunteer signature gatherers working to sign up 4,400 city voters by mid-July in order to quality the initiative for the November ballot.

Dear Ben,

Reviewing the materials that the Citizens for Two-Thirds committee submitted as part of its application to change reporting options, I see two matters that will require your immediate attention, and may complicate the committee's ability to change to the Full Reporting option. Please review this email and get back to me as soon as possible with the information requested.

- 1. As of June 3, 2013, the day you contacted me by telephone concerning a change in reporting options for your committee, it appears that Citizens for Two-Thirds committee had already accepted contributions from two sources that exceeded the \$500 limit of Mini Reporting on contributions from one source. As of May 30, 2013, Yakima Valley Publishing had contributed \$2,305 in in-kind contributions to the committee. As of May 30, 2013, contributions (including loans) from your personal funds totaled \$2,500. On June 7, 2013, you loaned another \$500 to the committee, bringing your personal aggregate contributions to \$3,000.
- 2. As of June 3, 2013, your committee's aggregate contributions totaled \$5,080, and its expenditures totaled \$4,699; according to your C-4 report, as of June 12, 2013, your committee has raised \$5,930 and spent \$5,227. (Although the C-4 report does not incorporate the in-kind contributions your committee received from Yakima Valley Publishing into your ongoing totals, note that in-kind contributions do count both as contributions and expenditures, and count toward the limits of Mini Reporting.)

Because your committee is currently out of compliance with the Mini Reporting limits, under <u>WAC 390-16-125(1)</u> PDC staff lacks the authority to process or approve your application to change reporting options. <u>In order to legally change reporting options</u>, <u>you will need to take steps to return to compliance with the Mini Limits</u>, <u>and document the steps you have taken</u>. The necessary steps may include cancelling outstanding orders and obtaining refunds of vendor payments in order to bring your total expenditures below \$5,000, which hopefully would free sufficient cash to make refunds and payments to contributors who have contributed more than \$500 in the aggregate.

If it is not possible for your committee to bring its total contributions and expenditures down to more than \$5,000, and its aggregate contributions from any one source to no more than \$500, for the remainder of your campaign you will stay registered under the Mini Reporting option, and in a position where you may have committed one or more violations of the PDC's chapter of law by exceeding the Mini limits before processing a change to Full Reporting. See <u>WAC 390-16-125{5}</u>. After reviewing this email with the other officers of your committee, please review your committee's books of account and come up with a plan to return to compliance with the Mini Reporting limits. At that point, please get back in touch with me to describe the steps you have taken, or plan to take. Whatever steps you identify to return to compliance will determine your options going forward.

Dear Ben,

Thanks for speaking with me a moment ago. The purpose of this email is to explain the steps required to change to the Full Reporting option, steps which must be completed <u>before</u> your committee exceeds the limits of the Mini Reporting option. Please read this email carefully through to the end.

In order to change from Mini Reporting to Full Reporting, your committee must complete the steps listed below on or before 30 business days before the relevant election. If your ballot proposition is in the August 6, 2013 primary, the deadline to apply for a change in reporting options is June 24, 2013. If your proposition is on the November 5, 2013 general election ballot, the deadline to take the required steps is September 23, 2013.

The required steps are as follows:

- File an amended <u>C-1pc registration</u> indicating a switch to Full Reporting;
- Notify any opposing committee(s) in writing of your plan to change reporting options
  (an email notification is sufficient, if you have the committee's email address, otherwise
  a first-class letter is appropriate);
- Send a letter to the PDC confirming the date and manner in which the opposing committee(s) were notified that your committee is changing reporting options; and
- File a <u>C-4 report</u> with the appropriate schedules (Schedules <u>A</u>, <u>B</u>, and <u>L</u>), and a <u>C-3</u> report, if any monetary contributions have been received, disclosing all contribution and

expenditure activity for the entire campaign, from the beginning of the campaign up to the day the reports are filed. The purpose of requiring these reports is to document that your committee is still in compliance with the limits of Mini Reporting at the time you request to change options.

Please note that your committee must stay within the limits of Mini Reporting option (i.e., no more than \$5,000 in total campaign contributions and expenditures, and no more than \$500 in contributions from any one source) until your request to change reporting options is complete and you have received written notification of the PDC Executive Director's approval. If the above steps are completed by the relevant deadline (see above), and your committee is still in compliance with the limits of the Mini Reporting option, your request to change options will be automatically approved.

Printable copies of the required PDC forms can be accessed by clicking on the above links. If your committee expects to spend \$5,000 or more in its campaign, you are required by law to file electronically; electronic reports can be filed through <a href="the PDC's free ORCA software">the PDC's free ORCA software</a>. For instructions on how to complete the C-3, C-4, and relevant schedule reports, please review the PDC's <a href="Manual of Reporting Instructions for Political Committees">Manual of Reporting Instructions for Political Committees</a>. For assistance with electronic filing, please contact Jennifer Hansen of PDC staff at (360) 586-4560 for assistance, or Chip Beatty at (360) 586-0616.

Thank you for the email regarding several further corrections needed to rectify the Citizens for Two-Thirds (Ballot Committee-BC) situation. In accordance with your email dated June 18, 2013 the BC did follow the recommended steps that could enable them to be in compliance.

"The necessary steps may include cancelling outstanding orders and obtaining refunds of vendor payments in order to bring your total expenditures below \$5,000, which hopefully would free sufficient cash to make refunds and payments to contributors who have contributed more than \$500 in the aggregate."

The forms recently sent in to you reflected the refunds made to contributors and they reflected the vendor refund from the Evergreen Petition Management.

One error in the reports sent in for June 30<sup>th</sup> was that we did not record the adjustments made to "reverse" the in-kind donations from Yakima Valley Publishing Inc. That was overlooked because the original C-4 report filed did not list this as an in-kind contribution and I had missed the notification of the in-kind attachment submitted on June 12<sup>th</sup>.

It appears that the remaining issues are primarily based on the "expenditure" side of the reports and possible potential "in-kind" situations.

- 1) The work done with Yakima Valley Publishing Inc. was originally considered to be an "in-kind contribution" and a Schedule A to the C-4 form was prepared. Since then, the BC decided to accept the responsibility of making full monetary payment and have requested an invoice be sent to them. As of June 30<sup>th</sup>, such invoice had not been received and subsequent actual payment NOT disbursed.
- 2) The Evergreen Petition Management has done work for the BC and progress payments were actually made. As of June 30<sup>th</sup> the Evergreen Petition Management LLC submitted a full refund of payments and intends to rebill their customer in one final invoice for the full amount of services rendered. However that final amount was not invoiced or received by the BC as of June 30<sup>th</sup>. The reason we reversed the full amount of the Evergreen Petition Management was that the vendor had submitted invoiced documents to reflect an adjustment they made in their bookkeeping. Evergreen Petition Management is NOT willing to "in-kind" the expense and they do want monetary payment for the work done so we do not feel that this situation warrants an in-kind report.

I believe we do need your assistance to clarify what constitutes the completion of expenditure such that it should be reported on the PDC report. It is our understanding that the expense on a PDC report should reflect

an accurate accounting of bank record keeping and (1) report expenditures when actual payment has incurred or (2) report services rendered that will not be financially compensated by the BC as in-kind donations. It appears that RCW 42.17A.005 appears to rely on accurate "books" as evidenced by deposits to the bank and payments written out of the account which implies that the exchange of cash is the primary evidence of what and when items are reported. The directions on the C-4 form also indicate that expenditures are based on actual payment made. In kind donations will be reported when the "donor" informs us that payment has been made and the BC is relieved of monetary payment. Donors can be the vendor itself when the vendor "forgives" the acceptance of monetary compensation for the services.

The Citizens for Two-Thirds has made a good faith attempt, in accordance to your recommendations to bring the account into compliance within the mini-reporting procedures. They have requested and received refund adjustments from the vendors that have, in real dollars and cents, put them into compliance as of the June 30<sup>th</sup> reporting period. The "bottom line" of the bank account properly reflects the adjustments that have been made as evidenced by written documents from vendors and properly recorded checks written to return donations.

We respectfully request that you accept the June 30<sup>th</sup> report that shows compliance to the mini-reporting guidelines and the timely filing of the request for changing to full reporting status to lift the restrictions and allow the campaign to proceed to full reporting status.

Thank you for your willingness to work with us through this situation.

Dear Mr. Shoval:

The staff of the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has reviewed your July 11, 2013, request to change from the Mini Reporting option to the Full Reporting option. Under WAC 390-16-125(1) of our agency's administrative rules, applicants who are registered under the Mini Reporting option must apply for a change in reporting options *before* the limits of that option are exceeded. Staff has learned that your committee exceeded the limits of the Mini Reporting option prior to completing your application to campaign at the Full Reporting level. Therefore, your application to change to the Full Reporting option cannot be processed or approved by the Executive Director of the PDC. A copy of the rule is enclosed.

As staff has learned, your committee exceeded the Mini Reporting limits as follows:

- 1. On June 3, 2013, PDC staff provided information to you via email regarding the rules for applying for a change in reporting options. Staff's email reminded you that applicants must submit a complete application and receive the approval of the PDC's Executive Director before exceeding the limits of Mini Reporting.
- 2. On June 12, 2013, Citizens for Two Thirds Committee submitted reports indicating that the committee had accepted contributions that exceeded the \$500 limit of Mini Reporting on contributions from one source. As of May 30, 2013, Yakima Valley Publishing had provided in-kind contributions of advertising to the committee valued at \$2,305. As of May 30, 2013, contributions (including loans) from your personal funds totaled \$2,500. On June 7, 2013, after receiving PDC staff's instructions regarding the Mini Reporting limits, you loaned another \$500 to the committee, bringing your personal aggregate contributions to \$3,000.

- 3. The reports submitted on June 12, 2013 indicated that as of that date, your committee had raised \$5,930 and spent \$5,227, exceeding the \$5,000 limit of Mini Reporting on aggregate contributions and expenditures.
- 4. On July 9, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds Committee submitted reports indicating that on June 17, 2013, the committee accepted a \$5,000 contribution attributed jointly to Bruce and Ginger Smith, again exceeding the \$500 limit of Mini Reporting on contributions from one source.
- 5. The reports submitted on July 9, 2013 indicate that from June 12 30, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds Committee conducted refunds of certain contributions. However, during this period the committee also accepted and retained \$3,935 in new contributions, bringing the committee's aggregate contributions to \$6,865 and further exceeding the \$5,000 limit of Mini Reporting on aggregate contributions.
- 6. The reports submitted on July 9, 2013 indicate that on June 12, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds Committee received a full refund of \$2,922 paid to Evergreen Petition Management, LLC between May 30, 2013 and June 7, 2013 for signature gathering services. However, on July 17, 2013, Sharon Hanek, a CPA assisting your committee, stated that Evergreen Petition Management, LLC did perform services for Citizens for Two-Thirds Committee, and expected payment from your committee, indicating that payments for signature gathering services cannot properly be deducted from the committee's expenditure totals. (PDC staff has noted media reports indicating that on Friday, July 5, 2013, your committee submitted sufficient qualifying signatures to place the two-thirds measure on the City of Yakima ballot, and that these signatures were collected through a combination of paid workers and volunteers.)
- 7. On July 17, 2013, Ms. Hanek stated that Citizens for Two-Thirds Committee determined it would pay Yakima Valley Publishing for \$2,305 in advertising reported as an in-kind contribution on June 12, 2013. She stated that the committee had requested an invoice from the company. This promise to pay for the advertising adds \$2,305 in expenditures to your committee's expenditure totals. Together with payments owed to Evergreen Petition Management, LLC and \$233 in additional expenditures, as of June 30, 2013, Citizens for Two-Thirds Committee's aggregate expenditures stood at \$5,460, exceeding the \$5,000 limit of Mini Reporting on aggregate expenditures.

Citizens for Two-Thirds Committee accepted contributions from four contributors that exceeded the \$500 Mini Reporting limit on contributions from one source. At its highest point, the committee's fundraising reached \$15,865, exceeding the \$5,000 Mini Reporting limit on aggregate contributions by more than \$10,000. As of June 30, 2013, the committee's expenditures remain approximately \$500 over the \$5,000 Mini Reporting

limit on total expenditures. As noted in the enclosed rule, exceeding the limits of the Mini Reporting option before seeking and receiving approval from the PDC for a change in reporting options "shall constitute one or more violations of chapter RCW 42.17A and WAC 390." Please remember that for the duration of the 2013 election, your committee remains registered under the limits of the Mini Reporting option. Additional contribution and expenditure activity in excess of the Mini Reporting limits may be viewed as aggravating a possible violation.

WAC 390-16-125

Mini campaign reporting—Exceeding limitations.

- (1) A candidate or political committee shall apply in writing to the commission for authorization to change reporting options before the limitations specified in WAC 390-16-105 are exceeded. A complete application shall include all of the following documents:
- (a) An amended registration statement (Form C-1 for candidates, Form C-1pc for political committees) selecting the full reporting option as provided in RCW 42.17A.225 through 42.17A.240;
- (b) PDC forms C-3 and C-4 with relevant schedules and attachments disclosing all contributions and expenditures to date reportable under RCW 42.17A.240 for the election campaign, or in the case of continuing political committees, for the calendar year; and
- (c)(i) If the applicant is a candidate, a statement affirming that all candidates registered with the commission for the office being sought have been notified personally in writing of the application, and the manner and date of such notification:
- (ii) If the applicant is the treasurer of a political committee supporting or opposing a ballot proposition, a statement affirming that all treasurers of all political committees registered with the commission as supporting or opposing the proposition have been notified personally in writing of the application, and the manner and date of such notification; or
- (iii) If the applicant is the treasurer of a county or legislative district party committee, a statement affirming that the treasurer of that party committee's counterpart in any other major political party has been notified personally in writing of the application, and the manner and date of such notification.
- (2) An application that is submitted without the required documents described in subsection (1) of this section is incomplete and will not be processed or approved. If the applicant provides the missing documents, the application will be determined to be complete on the date the documents are postmarked or delivered to the commission.
- (3) If a complete application is postmarked or delivered to the commission on or before thirty business days prior to the date of the election, the application shall be approved by the executive director.
- (4) If a complete application is postmarked or delivered to the commission on or after twenty-nine business days prior to the election, the application shall be approved by the executive director only if one or more of the following factors are present:
- (a) The applicant's campaign had its respective C1 or C1pc on file with the commission forty-one or more days before the election and the commission staff did not send to the applicant's campaign in a timely and proper manner, either electronically or by other mail delivery service, a notice that the thirtieth business day deadline for unrestricted changes in reporting options is approaching. To be timely and proper, this notice must be sent at least forty business days before the election to the campaign's electronic mail address or postal service mailing address specified on the registration statement;
- (b) The applicant is a candidate and, within thirty business days of the election, a write-in opponent has filed for office in accordance with chapter 29A.24 RCW;
- (c) Within thirty business days of the election, an independent expenditure as defined in RCW 42.17A.005 is made in support of the applicant's opponent or in opposition to the applicant; or
- (d) When a candidate or political committee on one side of an election campaign or proposition has been approved to change reporting options under this section, each opponent of that candidate or political committee is approved to change options as of the date that opponent postmarks or delivers a complete application to the commission.
- (5) Exceeding the aggregate contributions or aggregate expenditures specified in WAC 390-16-105 without complying with the provisions of this section shall constitute one or more violations of chapter 42.17A RCW or 390-17 WAC.

Dear Mr. Stutzman:

This letter constitutes a formal reply by the Citizens for Two-Thirds Committee (the Committee) to the investigation opened by the Public Disclosure Committee (PDC), Case No. 13-101.

Attached are new as well as amended PDC forms that fully disclose every contribution and expenditure by the Committee since its inception. It is the Committee's understanding that while still under Mini Reporting rules, these disclosures are neither required nor expected. However, in the Committee's interest in full disclosure of its activity, we have included these forms in order to demonstrate good faith as well as to provide backup documentation for the history of what has occurred in this case. The following information should provide additional context.

#### Background

When it filed on April 30, 2013, the Committee fully intended to operate completely within the limits of Mini Reporting. However, in late May, the Committee decided to hire a professional signature gathering firm to ensure ballot qualification, and determined that it would raise the necessary funds to pay for that expenditure. After realizing the added costs and the subsequent increased contributions would cause the Committee to exceed the limits of Mini Reporting, on May 28, 2013 Ben Shoval of the Committee left voice mails with Phil Stutzman, Nancy Krier, and Kurt Young seeking guidance on how to submit the appropriate application and begin full, regular reporting. On June 3, 2013, Tony Perkins returned these calls to Mr. Shoval and followed up with an email response. Attachment 1. The Committee then realized that they were uncertain as to how exactly to make the switch to regular reporting.

The Committee then retained Sharon Hanek, an accountant who represented herself as familiar with PDC laws and rules, to represent the Committee to the PDC and to guide the organization through the switch to full reporting, in addition to filing any PDC forms going forward.

Unfortunately, Ms. Hanek was confused by Mr. Perkins' suggestion in a June 18, 2103 email to Mr. Shoval that the Committee could return contributions, cancel orders of services or materials, and get refunds of expenses in effort to get back under Mini Reporting limits, and did not understand that services or products already received and utilized would remain expenditures, unpaid obligations, or in-kind contributions/expenses at the time they were ordered regardless of what the campaign bank account indicated. Attachment 2. Ms. Hanek erroneously believed and maintained that as long as actual funds in the account were less than \$5,000 and as long as the committee didn't

actually spend over \$5,000 regardless of outstanding obligations or bills not yet received, the committee was compliant with Mini Reporting. Attachments 3, 4, 5.

The Committee then executed multiple refunds of contributions and obtained refunds from vendors per Ms. Hanek's counsel again referring to Mr. Perkin's communications above. However, confusion still existed within the committee with regard to how to report the nature and extent of the ads run by Yakima Valley Publishing as well as the services by Evergreen Petition Management (Evergreen). See Attachments 3, 4, 5.

In the case of Yakima Valley Publishing, what was intended to be an in-kind contribution to the campaign was changed to a campaign obligation that the campaign agreed to pay in an effort to comply with Mini Reporting individual contribution limits. The Committee still intends to pay for these ads and reports them as an outstanding obligation.

In the case of Evergreen, estimates for services to be rendered were never reported, and bills paid to Evergreen were not reported while confusion existed regarding how to remain under the thresholds of Mini Reporting while applying for a permit to change to regular reporting.

It is at this point the Committee severed the relationship with Ms. Hanek and sought different professional assistance.

#### **Current Status**

As suggested by Mr. Perkins as way to become compliant with contribution limitations of Mini-Reporting, the Committee has refunded all contributions above \$500 from a single source. However, as will be evident in the accompanying documents, the committee has made expenditures in excess of the \$5,000 Mini Reporting limit. The Committee accepts responsibility for this overage for the reasons and circumstances described above, but at the same time would ask the PDC to consider early, good faith attempts to change reporting status before they had actually exceeded the Mini Reporting limit and the fact that they received erroneous compliance counsel from an individual who represented herself as an expert in these matters. The Committee also would ask the PDC to note that the largest expenditures and obligations, to Evergreen Petition Management and Yakima Valley Publishing, were at least partially disclosed early in reporting, and the public was aware of their involvement with the Committee well before this point. The full obligation to Evergreen is now reported in the attached documents.

A concern of the committee is how to pay off remaining obligations, including new legal and professional compliance assistance retained to resolve this matter. It would appear that the PDC maintains the committee is prohibited from raising more than \$5,000 even while its outstanding obligations are in excess of that amount simply because they will not ever be allowed out of the Mini Reporting regime. It is our understanding that the PDC maintains this position even though there is no actual limit on the size of contributions or the total amount that could be raised or spent by the Committee if it had chosen the better administrative filling option.

It should be noted that the Committee has incurred less than \$200 in expenditures or other obligations since June 30, 2013 and has received only one \$200 contribution in that period and that was refunded. Further, the Committee has had no contributions, expenditures nor incurred any obligations since the July 18th, 2013 denial of a reporting change by the PDC. The one exception is the obligation now being incurred to legal counsel and professional compliance services to resolve this matter.

The Committee intends to raise funds to pay off earlier unpaid obligations as wells as legal and compliance services. Please note, if they did not raise funds for these purposes, unpaid

expenditures would be reportable as in-kind contributions regardless, some of which may be over the \$500 Mini Reporting limit. In addition, if the Committee did not pay for these outstanding obligations, it would be liable to civil suit to recover damages and it is likely a court would order payment regardless.

#### Summary

The Committee acknowledges it has exceeded limits under the Mini Reporting option for disclosure. As the PDC determines a course of action, the Committee requests consideration of these factors:

- The numerous communications with the PDC from almost the inception of the Committee as well as their timing.
- That the vast majority of contributions and expenditures were reported and viewable to the public though incomplete, including Evergreen Petition Management and Yakima valley Publishing.
- The Committee's multiple efforts to seek professional compliance assistance.
- That even though Ms. Hanek had significant confusion about PDC law and regulation, she
  fully disclosed a variety of problematic entries to the PDC during her attempt to resolve
  these problems.
- In the interest of clarity and full disclosure to the public, the Committee has now reported all contributions and refunds (see attachments), despite there being no obligation to do so under Mini Reporting.

Thanks for speaking with me a moment ago. The purpose of this email is to explain the steps required to change to the Full Reporting option, steps which must be completed <u>before</u> your committee exceeds the limits of the Mini Reporting option. Please read this email carefully through to the end. In order to change from Mini Reporting to Full Reporting, your committee must complete the steps listed below on or before 30 business days before the relevant election. If your ballot proposition is in the August 6, 2013 primary, the deadline to apply for a change in reporting options is June 24, 2013. If your proposition is on the November 5, 2013 general election ballot, the deadline to take the required steps is September 23, 2013.

The required steps are as follows:

- File an amended C-1pc registration indicating a switch to Full Reporting;
- Notify any opposing committee(s) in writing of your plan to change reporting options (an email notification is sufficient, if you have the committee's email address, otherwise a first-class letter is appropriate);
- Send a letter to the PDC confirming the date and manner in which the opposing committee(s) were notified that your committee is changing reporting options; and
- File a <u>C-4 report</u> with the appropriate schedules (Schedules <u>A</u>, <u>B</u>, and <u>L</u>), and a <u>C-3 report</u>, if any monetary contributions have been received, disclosing all contribution and expenditure activity for the entire campaign, from the beginning of the campaign up to the day the reports are filed. The purpose of requiring these reports is to document that your committee is still in compliance with the limits of Mini Reporting at the time you request to change options.

Please note that your committee must stay within the limits of Mini Reporting option (i.e., no more than \$5,000 in total campaign contributions and expenditures, and no more than \$500 in contributions from any one source) until your request to change reporting options is complete and you have received written notification of the PDC Executive Director's approval. If the above steps are completed by the relevant deadline (see above), and your committee is still in compliance with the limits of the Mini Reporting option, your request to change options will be automatically approved. Printable copies of the required PDC forms can be accessed by clicking on the above links. If your committee expects to spend \$5,000 or more in its campaign, you are required by law to file electronically; electronic reports can be filed through the PDC's free ORCA software. For instructions on how to complete the C-3, C-4, and relevant schedule reports, please review the PDC's Manual of Reporting Instructions for Political Committees. For assistance with electronic filing, please contact Jennifer Hansen of PDC staff at (360) 586-4560 for assistance, or Chip Beatty at (360) 586-0616. I am the member of PDC staff charged with reviewing applications to change reporting options, so feel free to contact me with any questions about the process of applying for a change. If you'd like to send me draft filings by fax or email attachment prior to submission, I would be happy to review them and get back to you about any problems I see.

Reviewing the materials that the Citizens for Two-Thirds committee submitted as part of its application to change reporting options, I see two matters that will require your immediate attention, and may complicate the committee's ability to change to the Full Reporting option. Please review this email and get back to me as soon as possible with the information requested.

- 1. As of June 3, 2013, the day you contacted me by telephone concerning a change in reporting options for your committee, it appears that Citizens for Two-Thirds committee had already accepted contributions from two sources that exceeded the \$500 limit of Mini Reporting on contributions from one source. As of May 30, 2013, Yakima Valley Publishing had contributed \$2,305 in in-kind contributions to the committee. As of May 30, 2013, contributions (including loans) from your personal funds totaled \$2,500. On June 7, 2013, you loaned another \$500 to the committee, bringing your personal aggregate contributions to \$3,000.
- 2. As of June 3, 2013, your committee's aggregate contributions totaled \$5,080, and its expenditures totaled \$4,699; according to your C-4 report, as of June 12, 2013, your committee has raised \$5,930 and spent \$5,227. (Although the C-4 report does not incorporate the in-kind contributions your committee received from Yakima Valley Publishing into your ongoing totals, note that in-kind contributions do count both as contributions and expenditures, and count toward the limits of Mini Reporting.)

Because your committee is currently out of compliance with the Mini Reporting limits, under <u>WAC 390-16-125(1)</u> PDC staff lacks the authority to process or approve your application to change reporting options. <u>In order to legally change reporting options</u>, you will need to take steps to return to compliance with the Mini Limits, and document the steps you have taken. The necessary steps may include cancelling outstanding orders and obtaining refunds of vendor payments in order to bring your total expenditures below \$5,000, which hopefully would free sufficient cash to make refunds and payments to contributors who have contributed more than \$500 in the aggregate.

If it is not possible for your committee to bring its total contributions and expenditures down to more than \$5,000, and its aggregate contributions from any one source to no more than \$500, for the remainder of your campaign you will stay registered under the Mini Reporting option, and in a position where you may have committed one or more violations of the PDC's chapter of law by exceeding the Mini limits before processing a change to Full Reporting. See <u>WAC 390-16-125(5)</u>. After reviewing this email with the other officers of your committee, please review your committee's books of account and come up with a plan to return to compliance with the Mini Reporting limits. At that point, please get back in touch with me to describe the steps you have taken, or plan to take. Whatever steps you identify to return to compliance will determine your options going forward.

The directors of the "Citizens for Two-Thirds" initiative committee out of Yakima contacted me to assist them with regard to their attempt to change from a mini-reporting period to full reporting. They had notified the PDC earlier this month requesting the change, however they had accepted and spent funds - in error - beyond the mini reporting limits.

You had advised them of some steps to take to remedy the situation before any action could be taken by PDC to approve this change in reporting. After a phone discussion between their directors and myself we have taken the recommendation you sent in your email to Mr. Ben Shoval and plan immediate action steps to reverse several transactions. We have outlined our plan of action below and hope to have copies of the documents in your office early next week. Please advise us of any further suggestions you might have for our intentions to remedy the situation.

- 1) Send out refund checks to any single donor over \$500.00 (including monetary refunds for in-kind donations)
- 2) Send out refund checks to donors who caused the total contributions received to exceed \$5,000.
- 3) Contacted vendors to reduce services and request refund checks from them in order to decrease expenditures below \$5,000.

The vendor refunds will be able to cover the payments back to the donors.

These steps should put the campaign back to the proper limits for mini-reporting.

We respectfully request that after presenting to you documentation you will be able to approve the change to full reporting. The original request was submitted in a timely manner and we trust that this notification will be accepted as meeting with the proper deadlines.

Thank you for the email regarding several further corrections needed to rectify the Citizens for Two-Thirds (Ballot Committee-BC) situation. In accordance with your email dated June 18, 2013 the BC did follow the recommended steps that could enable them to be in compliance.

"The necessary steps may include cancelling outstanding orders and obtaining refunds of vendor payments in order to bring your total expenditures below \$5,000, which hopefully would free sufficient cash to make refunds and payments to contributors who have contributed more than \$500 in the aggregate."

The forms recently sent in to you reflected the refunds made to contributors and they reflected the vendor refund from the Evergreen Petition Management.

One error in the reports sent in for June 30<sup>th</sup> was that we did not record the adjustments made to "reverse" the in-kind donations from Yakima Valley Publishing Inc. That was overlooked because the original C-4 report filed did not list this as an in-kind contribution and I had missed the notification of the in-kind attachment submitted on June 12<sup>th</sup>.

It appears that the remaining issues are primarily based on the "expenditure" side of the reports and possible potential "in-kind" situations.

- 1) The work done with Yakima Valley Publishing Inc. was originally considered to be an "in-kind contribution" and a Schedule A to the C-4 form was prepared. Since then, the BC decided to accept the responsibility of making full monetary payment and have requested an invoice be sent to them. As of June 30<sup>th</sup>, such invoice had not been received and subsequent actual payment NOT disbursed.
- 2) The Evergreen Petition Management has done work for the BC and progress payments were actually made. As of June 30<sup>th</sup> the Evergreen Petition Management LLC submitted a full refund of payments and intends to rebill their customer in one final invoice for the full amount of services rendered. However that final amount was not invoiced or received by the BC as of June 30<sup>th</sup>. The reason we reversed the full amount of the Evergreen Petition Management was that the vendor had submitted invoiced documents to reflect an adjustment they made in their bookkeeping. Evergreen Petition Management is NOT willing to "in-kind" the expense and they do want monetary payment for the work done so we do not feel that this situation warrants an in-kind report.

I believe we do need your assistance to clarify what constitutes the completion of expenditure such that it should be reported on the PDC report. It is our understanding that the expense on a PDC report should reflect an accurate accounting of bank record keeping and (1) report expenditures when actual payment has incurred or (2) report services rendered that will not be financially compensated by the BC as in-kind donations. It appears that RCW 42.17A.005 appears to rely on accurate "books" as evidenced by deposits to the bank and payments

written out of the account which implies that the exchange of cash is the primary evidence of what and when items are reported. The directions on the C-4 form also indicate that expenditures are based on actual payment made. In kind donations will be reported when the "donor" informs us that payment has been made and the BC is relieved of monetary payment. Donors can be the vendor itself when the vendor "forgives" the acceptance of monetary compensation for the services.

The Citizens for Two-Thirds has made a good faith attempt, in accordance to your recommendations to bring the account into compliance within the mini-reporting procedures. They have requested and received refund adjustments from the vendors that have, in real dollars and cents, put them into compliance as of the June 30<sup>th</sup> reporting period. The "bottom line" of the bank account properly reflects the adjustments that have been made as evidenced by written documents from vendors and properly recorded checks written to return donations.

We respectfully request that you accept the June 30<sup>th</sup> report that shows compliance to the mini-reporting guidelines and the timely filing of the request for changing to full reporting status to lift the restrictions and allow the campaign to proceed to full reporting status.

Thank you for your willingness to work with us through this situation.
