Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 Mr. Costanti is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$12,000 or more during the previous 12 months, to Curt Maberry Farm, Inc. Mr. Costanti's spouse, Angela Kay Costanti works in Human Resources of Curt Maberry Farm, Inc. with a 33% ownership interest. Mr. Costanti stated that he has no ownership interest in the company and is not involved in the day to day operations.

	 Mr. Costanti stated that Curt Maberry Farm, Inc. grows and processes berries from approximately 1000 acres in Whatcom County.
	 Mr. Costanti stated that Curt Maberry Farm, Inc. has 70 full-time and 350 additional employees seasonally. 99% of the company's sales are outside of Whatcom County and 80% of sales are outside of Washington State.
	Mr. Costanti stated that Curt Maberry Farm, Inc. has approximately 50 customers annually. Almost all of the customers would be reportable.
	Mr. Costanti stated that the customers of Curt Maberry Farm, Inc. are not publicly available.
	 Mr. Costanti stated that Curt Maberry Farm operates in a very competitive market and industry and is a leader in his area. He further stated that publishing the reportable business customers would put the business at a competitive disadvantage.
	 Mr. Costanti stated the Lynden School District 504 does no business with Curt Maberry Farm, Inc. and that there are no reportable governmental customers.
Other Issues	Mr. Costanti stated that if any matter came before him involving Curt Maberry Farm, Inc., that he would recuse himself.
