- 3) Both RCW 42.17A.205 & RCW 42.17A.700 by failing to file or timely file a C-1 and F-1 report within two weeks of declaring candidacy or not later than June 1, 2018.

To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing this missive in response to an email received on 17 August and subsequent telephone call with Fox Blackhorn, a compliance employee of the Public Disclosure Commission. Both the email and conversation were regarding my alleged failure to file this April with the PDC. After discussing the situation with Mr. Blackhorn, he suggested I write to you and explain my circumstances,

I was initially elected to serve on the Board of Directors for the Goldendale School District in November of 1992. Upon my declaration of candidacy, I filed for the first time. Every year subsequent to my election, I have filed either the short F-1 or long form F-1A as required by RCW 42.17A.700. PDC records will confirm my annual timely filing.

The majority of my interaction with the PDC has been through the U.S. Mall. One year, I actually filed in the Olympia office. A very few times I filed online but, due to my lack of technological acumen, have found paper to be easier. AS has been past practice, I completed and mailed my required documentation to the PDC on Tuesday, 10 April, 2018.

My circumstances preclude paying fines, particularly for those unwarranted. I have been unable to work since July 2014. I live on Social Security Disability monthly amount of \$976.00 as my only source of income. I pay my tithe, house payment, taxes, insurance, utilities and prescription co pays each month. Any residual funds are used to transport me to medical appointments and to purchase groceries and necessary sundries.

My home is not yet mortgage free and will not be so for several years. My 2001 vehicle, while completely paid for, has over 305,000.00 miles on the odometer. I live as frugally as possible with the funds available to me. My savings were expended prior to becoming disabled. My time is much more readily available than are my fiscal resources.

In order to still be a contributing member of society, I serve my faith community. I volunteer for the local hospital. I am actively involved with county and local 4-H programs.

I have faithfully served the Goldendale School District for twenty-five years. During that time, I have also served the Washington State School Directors' Association in myriad capacities, including being the association president. I continue to strive for all that being a publicly elected servant entails; to uphold the Constitution of the United States of America and the Constitution of Washington State.

I feel that penalizing me due to mischance of the U.S Postal Service is unjust. I ask you to reconsider fining me or asking me to travel to Olympia to plead my case.

RCW 42.17A.700 requires every elected or appointed official to file an annual F-1 report, which was to have been filed no later than April 16, 2018. On July 16, 2018, PDC staff sent you a warning letter reminding you to file the missing F-1 report.

In accordance with RCW 42.17A.110 and RCW 42.17A.755, a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Brief Enforcement Hearing) has been scheduled to determine if you violated RCW 42.17A.700 by failing to file the required annual F-1 report for calendar year 2017. Under the Brief Enforcement Hearing rules, the Presiding Officer has the authority to assess civil penalties in accordance with WAC 390-37-143, a penalty schedule adopted by the Commission (see enclosed copy).
