Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ms. Ehrlichman is requesting a renewal of the reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing the business and other governmental customers that paid \$10,000 or more during 2012 to Dorsey & Whitney, LLP, a law firm.. • Ms. Ehrlichman's spouse, Peter Ehrlichman, is a partner in the Seattle office of Dorsey & Whitney and has less than a 1% ownership interest in the firm. Dorsey & Whitney, based out of Minnesota, has 19 offices worldwide, 250 partners, and more than 400 attorneys. The Seattle office has approximately 65 attorneys. • Ms. Ehrlichman stated that the firm has over 10,000 clients worldwide, most of whom would be reportable, and compiling this information would create a significant hardship on the law firm. • Ms. Ehrlichman stated she is not involved with the operations of the firm. She said that, other than his own clients, her spouse is not involved in the day-to-day operations of the firm. The firm's clients are not disclosed in any marketing materials or in Martindale-Hubbell.
Other Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ms. Ehrlichman stated that Dorsey & Whitney does not do business with the Shoreline School District and did not make any payments to the district. • Ms. Ehrlichman disclosed the business clients for whom her spouse provided legal services during 2012. She said he had no governmental customers.

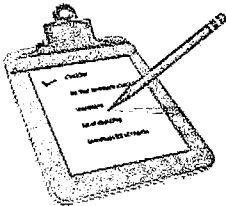

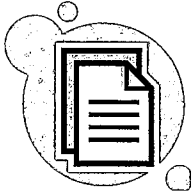

I, Deborah Ehrlichman, respectfully request a reporting modification for my husband, Peter Ehrlichman, regarding Dorsey & Whitney, LLP, the law firm in which he is a partner, restricting the disclosure requirements to those clients for whom he has personally supplied legal services in excess of \$10,000.00 in 2012.

Dorsey & Whitney is a global law firm based in Minneapolis, MN, with 19 offices including international offices in Hong Kong, Shanghai, London, Toronto, and Vancouver, as well as many offices throughout the U.S.

- Describe the size of the entity such as annual sales, number of customers or accounts, the number of employees, and other pertinent information.

D&W is estimated to be within the top 100 law firms by size and revenue in the country. It has approximately 250 partners and 400 attorneys practicing within the 19 offices. In the Seattle office alone there are approximately 65 attorneys. While the exact number of D&W clients is difficult to determine without substantial effort, it is estimated that the number of clients would easily exceed 10,000.

- Describe how many business customers or other sources paying the entity more than \$10,000 would be subject to disclosure.

The majority of those clients would have billings for legal services in excess of \$10,000.

I am not involved in any way with the operations of the firm. Information concerning the identities of the firm's clients and the fees

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incurred by those clients is not available to me, is not disclosed in any public forum or in Martindale-Hubbell, on the firm's web page or in any promotional material. As a partner in the Seattle office, my husband, Peter Ehrlichman, is not regularly involved in the day to day operations with Dorsey clients other than his own. On April 26, 2012, the application of Deborah Ehrlichman, 5105 NE 180th Street, Lake Forest Park, Washington 98155, for a modification of the reporting requirements of RCW 42.17.241¹ was brought before the Public Disclosure Commission.

Consideration of the request was made pursuant to RCW 42.17A.120² and chapter 390-28 WAC by the Commission. The proceedings were held in Room 206, Evergreen Plaza Building, 711 Capitol Way, Olympia, Washington, 98504. The applicant, Deborah Ehrlichman, by letter and Modification Application, requested a renewal of the reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing the business and other governmental customers that paid \$10,000 or more during 2011 to Dorsey & Whitney, LLP, a law firm of which her spouse is a partner.

The Commission was provided with a certification from Ms. Ehrlichman waiving her personal appearance at the hearing and stating that the facts contained in the request are true and accurate.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Based upon the letter and Modification Application, the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact:

1. Ms. Ehrlichman has previously been granted the requested reporting modification, the most recent being Order No. 2991.
2. Ms. Ehrlichman is a School Board member for the Shoreline School District. Her term of office expires December 31, 2013.
3. Ms. Ehrlichman's spouse, Peter Ehrlichman, is a partner in the Seattle office of Dorsey & Whitney and has less than a 1% ownership interest in the firm. Dorsey & Whitney, based out of Minnesota, has 19 offices worldwide, 250 partners, and more than 400 attorneys. The Seattle office has approximately 65 attorneys.
4. Ms. Ehrlichman stated that the firm has over 10,000 clients worldwide, most of whom would be reportable, and compiling this information would create a significant hardship on the law firm.

5. Ms. Ehrlichman stated she is not involved with the operations of the firm. She said that other than his own clients, her spouse is not involved in the day-to-day operations of the firm. The firm's clients are not disclosed in any marketing materials or in Martindale-Hubbell.
6. Ms. Ehrlichman stated that Dorsey & Whitney does not do business with the Shoreline School District and did not make any payments to the district.
7. Ms. Ehrlichman disclosed the business clients for whom her spouse provided legal services during 2011. She said he had no governmental customers.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Having made these Findings of Fact, the Commission makes the following Conclusions of Law:

1. Literal compliance with all the provisions of the reporting requirements of RCW 42.17.241³ would work a manifestly unreasonable hardship on the applicant.
2. Limited suspension or modification of the reporting requirements as specified in the Order would not frustrate the purposes of the Act in this particular case.

ORDER

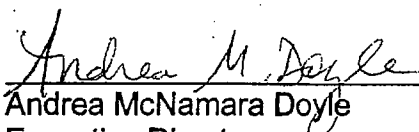
Having made these Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Commission issues the following Order:

For the Statement of Personal Financial Affairs required to be filed with the Public Disclosure Commission between January 1 and April 16, 2012:

1. The applicant shall report all payments made by the Shoreline School District to Dorsey & Whitney, LLP during the reporting period.
2. The applicant may satisfy the reporting requirements of RCW 42.17.241³ without disclosing the reportable business and other governmental customers of Dorsey & Whitney, LLP, except that she must disclose the reportable information of which she is aware.
3. The applicant shall disclose the reportable business and other governmental customers or clients of Dorsey & Whitney, LLP during the reporting period, whose identities are known to the applicant and whose interests are significantly affected by the Shoreline School District, to the extent not otherwise disclosed in (1) and (2).
4. In all other matters required to be reported, the applicant shall comply in full with the reporting requirements of RCW 42.17/42.17A.
