The request includes the current reporting period (2012) and a request for a retroactive modification that would apply to the F-1 &amp; F-1A reports he previously filed for calendar years 2009 – 2011.</li> <li>Mr. Benton stated that The Benton Group is a marketing and advertising company located in Washington. Mr. Benton stated that has been actively running the company for 25 years until May 2012 when his full time management ceased. He stated that he retained the title of CEO and chief trainer for the company even after his involvement in the day-to-day operations ceased. Mr. Benton stated that his wife also has an ownership interest in The Benton Group.</li> <li>Mr. Benton stated that The Benton Group has approximate average sales of \$600,000 in any given year and employs two to five staff.</li> <li>Mr. Benton stated that The Benton Group has approximately 600 total clients with 120 of these clients paying \$10,000 or more during a calendar year.</li> <li>Mr. Benton stated that the primary focus of the company is sales consulting and revenue program consulting and training for television stations and media companies worldwide.
