Explanation of Rule(s)	<p>Personal residence - Real property. Regarding reporting the information otherwise required by RCW 42.17A.710 (1)(h) through (k):</p> <p>(i) Under WAC 390-24-200, the filer shall list the street address of each parcel, the assessor's parcel number, the abbreviated legal description appearing on property tax statements, or the complete legal description. Each property description shall be followed by the name of the county in which the property is located.</p> <p>(ii) No modification will be necessary if the filer describes the real property using one of the alternatives in WAC 390-24-200, plus the name of the county.</p> <p>(iii) A modification will be required if the filer seeks some other means to describe reportable real property including the personal residence of the filer. The commission may consider a modification, for example, when the filer or his or her immediate family member has received a threat, has a no contact order, or presents a similar personal safety concern.</p> <p>A prospective modification to allow nondisclosure of a residential address may be granted if the applicant or an immediate family member has received a threat, been issued a no contact order or presents a similar personal safety concern.</p>

She said that she has been threatened by individual appearing before her.• Judge Donohue stated in previous requests that she has received threats from violent offenders, including one individual who harbors cannibalistic fantasies toward women. In 2014 a defendant appearing in her court on a harassment charge, who after being found guilty in another courtroom, appeared at the home of one of the court staff.• Judge Donohue stated that in December 2015 she received a threatening letter at her home from someone identifying themselves as a previous criminal defendant.• Judge Donohue stated that in 2016 she received a threat sent to her home from someone purporting to be an inmate in the King County jail.
Other Issues	Judge Donohue disclosed creditor information, payment terms, security given and mortgage amounts for her personal residence.
Staff Recommendations	Approve renewal of the reporting modification with no change.
