Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 Mr. Hansen is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$10,000 or more during 2013 to Susman Godfrey LLP, a law firm.
	 Mr. Hansen is an attorney with Susman Godfrey. He said the firm has offices in five cities (Dallas, Houston, Seattle, New York, Los Angeles) with approximately 90 attorneys and 100 non-attorney staff. He said he is not a managing partner or part of the firm's Executive Committee.
	 Mr. Hansen stated that he does not perform any legal work for a majority of the firm's clients. He stated that his service in the Washington State Legislature does not affect most of the firm's clients since many of the clients are outside of Washington. He stated that he disclosed those clients of the firm whose interests could be affected by his actions as a State Representative.
	Mr. Hansen provided a list disclosing his clients, clients whose interests would be significantly affected by his actions as a State Representative, clients who are identified in court files or other public sources, and the firm's governmental clients.
	 Mr. Hansen said that the firm handles anti-trust and patent issues, among other issues. He said that, for example, a client has retained the firm in order to obtain a patent but if the client's business partners became aware that he retained legal counsel, they would know why and it would jeopardize the client's business relationship.
