Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<ul> <li>Personal Residential Address</li> <li>Judge Martin is requesting a renewal of a reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing her personal residential address information, including street address, parcel number, or legal description, on her Personal Financial Affairs Statement for 2013.</li> <li>Judge Martin stated that for safety and security concerns she does not want to disclose her personal residential address information.</li> <li>Judge Martin stated that as a Superior Court Judge, she has adjudicated a variety of criminal and civil matters, including sentencing violent felons and gang members.</li> <li>Gordon Thomas Honeywell, LLP</li> <li>Judge Martin is requesting a renewal of a reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing the reportable business customers of the law firm, Gordon Thomas Honeywell, LLP, that paid \$10,000 or more during 2013, for which her spouse is a partner.</li> <li>Judge Martin stated that Gordon Thomas Honeywell, LLP is a Tacoma law firm with 30 partners and approximately 45 total lawyers. Her spouse's ownership interest of 3.3809%.</li> <li>Judge Martin said she does not have access to the client base or compensation information of Gordon Thomas Honeywell.</li> </ul>

	Judge Martin stated that, upon her request, Gordon Thomas Honeywell staff informed her that approximately 1,000 business clients would be subject to disclosure.
	<ul> <li>Judge Martin stated that, pursuant to Code of Judicial Conduct, Cannon 3(d), she has, and will continue to, recuse herself from all matters in which (1) a Gordon Thomas Honeywell lawyer represents a party; (2) involve a party which Judge Martin or Mr. Martin previously represented, or (3) involve a party personally known by Judge Martin to be a client of the firm.</li> </ul>
Other Issues	Judge Martin provided a list of reportable business clients known to her and a list of reportable governmental clients of her spouse's firm, Gordon Thomas Honeywell.
