<b>Explanation of Rule(s)</b>	<p><b>Personal residence - Real property.</b> Regarding reporting the information otherwise required by RCW <a href="#">42.17A.710</a> (1)(h) through (k):</p> <p>(i) Under WAC <a href="#">390-24-200</a>, the filer shall list the street address of each parcel, the assessor's parcel number, the abbreviated legal description appearing on property tax statements, or the complete legal description. Each property description shall be followed by the name of the county in which the property is located.</p> <p>(ii) No modification will be necessary if the filer describes the real property using one of the alternatives in WAC <a href="#">390-24-200</a>, plus the name of the county.</p> <p>(iii) A modification will be required if the filer seeks some other means to describe reportable real property including the personal residence of the filer. The commission may consider a modification, for example, when the filer or his or her immediate family member has received a threat, has a no contact order, or presents a similar personal safety concern.</p> <p>A prospective modification to allow nondisclosure of a residential address may be granted if the applicant or an immediate family member has received a threat, been issued a no contact order or presents a similar personal safety concern.</p>

<b>Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Judge Garratt is requesting a renewal of the reporting modification that would exempt her from reporting real estate, including street address, parcel number, or legal description, for two properties she owns, on her Personal Financial Affairs Statement for 2017.</li><li>• Judge Garratt was previously a board member of the Indeterminate Sentence Review Board for 14 years. She stated that there were several instances where offenders threatened her life and she was contacted by internal investigations of different prisons. Judge Garratt stated she also received a threat at her home. In addition, her husband, Robert Zarate, is currently employed by the Washington State Department of Corrections. Mr. Zarate has held this position for 33 years and has personally received multiple threats.</li></ul>
<b>Other Issues</b>	Judge Garratt disclosed the creditor information, payment terms, security given and mortgage amounts for two properties she owns as required under statute and rule.
