| Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mr. Hein is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$10,000 or more during the previous 12 months, when he was a candidate, as well as calendar year 2013, to Shoemaker Manufacturing. • Mr. Hein serves as president with an ownership interest of 1.5%. • Mr. Hein stated that Shoemaker Manufacturing is a heating, ventilation and air conditioning manufacturing company located in Cle Elum which performs precision manufacturing services for the HVAC industry. • Mr. Hein stated that Shoemaker Manufacturing has 85 employees at their Cle Elum facility as well as 37 contracted salesmen throughout the United States. • Mr. Hein stated that Shoemaker Manufacturing has annual sales of approximately \$16 million and has 200 customers, all of which meet the reporting threshold. He also stated that there are no reportable governmental customers. • Mr. Hein stated that Shoemaker Manufacturing is a privately held company and that a list of its customers is not publically available. • Mr. Hein stated that the HVAC manufacturing industry is highly competitive and publishing the reportable business customers would put them at a serious competitive disadvantage. • Mr. Hein stated that none of the reportable business customers are located in the Cle Elum – Roslyn school district and that neither those customers or Shoemaker Manufacturing do business with the Cle Elum – Roslyn School District. • Mr. Hein stated that it would be a hardship, given the time required, to compile a |
