Explanation of Rule(s)	Income and ownership interests: WAC 390-28-100(1)(b)  (1) Under RCW 42.17A.120, the commission or presiding officer may modify reporting requirements, including the statement of financial affairs, if literal application of the requirement would work a manifestly unreasonable hardship and the suspension or modification would not frustrate the purpose of the law. One or more of the following may be considered by the commission or presiding officer as possible qualifications for a reporting modification with respect to the statement of financial affairs, when such standard is met:  (b) Income and ownership interests. An applicant may be exempted from reporting the information otherwise required by RCW 42.17A.710 (1)(f) and (g), if:  (i) Public disclosure would violate any legally recognized confidential relationship that serves a legitimate business interest;  (ii) The information does not relate to a business entity which would be subject to the regulatory authority of the office sought or held by the applicant in whole or in part;  (iii) Such reporting would present a manifestly unreasonable hardship to the applicant including but not limited to adversely affecting the competitive position of an entity in which the applicant had an interest of ten percent or more as described in RCW 42.17A.120; and  (iv) The interest in question would present no actual or potential conflict with the performance of the duties of the office sought or held.

Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	Ms. McGourty is requesting a partial reporting modification to not disclose business customers that paid \$12,000 or more to McH Scientific during the reporting period, calendar year 2019.
	<ul> <li>Ms. McGourty states that McH Scientific has varied non-disclosure agreements with their customers, and that she has not disclosed this one customer through public sources, publications, websites, or other public records.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ms. McGourty states that McH Scientific is a scientific consulting company with two to three business customers per year and no governmental customers would be reportable.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ms. McGourty has disclosed the McH Scientific customer that meets the threshold and is under a less restrictive nondisclosure agreement for 2019.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ms. McGourty states that McH Scientific is run by herself and her spouse, with no other employees.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ms. McGourty states that she does have access to McH Scientific's customer list, has the ability to sort those customers paying \$12,000 or more, and is involved in the day-to-day operations of the business.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ms. McGourty states that the company has 2 to 3 customers per year and grosses approximately \$70,000 annually.</li> </ul>
Other Issues	<ul> <li>Ms. McGourty states that there is no overlap between the business conducted by McH Scientific and the Northshore School District.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ms. McGourty has agreed to recuse herself if any conflict arises with her position as a School Director for Northshore School District 417 and McH Scientific.</li> </ul>
