Re: Request for Electronic Filing Exception

Background: A candidate who spends \$5,000 is required to file contribution and expenditure reports electronically (as opposed to filing paper reports). The Commission may make exceptions on a case-by-case basis for candidates who lack the technological ability to file reports electronically. RCW 42.17A.250.

<u>Agenda Item</u>: Mark Miloscia has requested that the Commission except his 2012 State Representative campaign from electronically filing a final Campaign Summary Receipts & Expenditures (C-4) report.

- Mark Miloscia was a State Representative for the 30th Legislative District from 1999 2012.
- August 2011: Mr. Miloscia accepted two contributions totaling \$500 and registered the 2012 Miloscia for State Representative campaign. The campaign reported a starting balance of \$5,000 carried forward from the 2010 campaign. No other receipts were reported.
- September 2011: Mr. Miloscia registered the 2012 Miloscia for State Auditor campaign. \$5,250 was transferred from the state representative to the state auditor campaign during September and October 2011, leaving a balance of \$250 in the state representative account at the end of October. Mr. Miloscia states that the state representative account had no reportable transactions after October 2011 until the account was closed in December 2012.
- The state representative campaign electronically filed all contribution and expenditure reports in 2011 using the PDC's ORCA software. Mr. Miloscia states that the ORCA data file was lost when his computer hard drive crashed in May 2012.
- Mr. Miloscia further states that he closed the state representative campaign bank account on December 18, 2012. Monthly bank fees had reduced the account balance to \$86.25, which he deposited in his surplus funds account. A final C-4 report was filed on paper on February 25, 2013, along with the request for an electronic filing exception.

Electronic filing exceptions have been granted in the past to candidates in similar situations (i.e., where computer failures resulted in lost data), most recently to Senator Don Benton and former State Representative Shay Shual-Berke for their 2008 campaigns. Staff recommends that the Commission grant Mark Miloscia's request to except the 2012 Miloscia for State Representative campaign from filing its final report electronically.

Due to a crash of my computer hard drive during my State Auditor Campaign in May 2012, all my PDC Orca data was lost and I was unable to recover my back-up for my State Auditor Campaign, Mark Miloscia Surplus funds account and Mark Miloscia for State Representative Account.

My campaign team (Martin Moore/Campaign Manager, Scott Miloscia/Treasure) and myself spent considerable hours recovering the State Auditor Campaign and were able to continue the electronic filing. However, we were unable to recreate electronically the Surplus funds account and the Mark Miloscia for State Representative (2012) account. Fortunately, very minimal activity occurred before we closed both out.

Enclosed in the final C-4 and schedule A for the State Representative account. The only activities the previous 13 months (12/01/11 to 12/21/12) was a transfer of \$86.25 to the Miloscia Surplus funds Account on 18 Dec 2012 and 13 separate monthly bank and paper service fees to Key Bank totaling \$163.75.

This zeros out and closes my bank account and PDC account for Mark Miloscia For State Representative (2012).

Respectfully request that you accept this paper filing rather than electronic filing.


