	 Mr. Smith disclosed on the F-1 Supplement that the University of Washington made payments to Nike totaling \$352,800, in 2013, for athletic supplies.
	 The Walt Disney Company Mr. Smith stated that The Walt Disney Company is a worldwide company and in 2013, had annual sales of \$45 billion and 175,000 employees.
