Mr. Smith serves on the Board of Directors for both entities.</li> </ul> <p><u>Nike, Inc.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mr. Smith stated that Nike, Inc. is a worldwide company with 48,000 employees and annual sales of \$25.3 billion.</li> <li>• Mr. Smith stated that, as a board member for Nike, he does not have access to information about the business and other governmental customers and is not aware of how many would be subject to disclosure.</li> <li>• Mr. Smith stated that Nike, Inc. is a very large organization and attempting to collect and summarize the business and other governmental customers would be extremely difficult.</li> <li>• Mr. Smith disclosed on the F-1 Supplement that the University of Washington made payments to Nike totaling \$352,800, in 2013, for athletic supplies.</li> </ul> <p><u>The Walt Disney Company</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mr. Smith stated that The Walt Disney Company is a worldwide company and in 2013, had annual sales of \$45 billion and 175,000 employees.</li> <li>• Mr. Smith stated that as a board member for The Walt Disney Company</li> </ul>
