I. Jurisdiction

1. The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to Chapter 42.17A RCW, the state's campaign disclosure and contribution law; Chapter 34.05 RCW, the Administrative Procedure Act; and Title 390 WAC. These charges incorporate the Report of Investigation and all related exhibits by reference.

II. Allegations

2. PDC staff alleges that Patrick K. McElligott, a candidate for East Pierce County Fire Commissioner in 2015, violated: (1) RCW 42.17A.235 and 42.17A.240 by failing to timely file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports) disclosing contribution and expenditure activities undertaken by his 2015 campaign; and (2) RCW 42.17A.245 by failing to timely file C-3 and C-4 reports electronically using the PDC Online Reporting of Campaign Activities (ORCA) campaign finance software, or other similar software.

III. Facts

3. On July 9, 2015, Patrick K. McElligott filed a Candidate Registration (C-1 report) declaring his candidacy for East Pierce County Fire Commissioner in 2015, selecting the Full Reporting Option. The C-1 report listed Bruce Baurichter as the Campaign Treasurer, and Carol Wagner as a person performing Ministerial duties for the Campaign. Mr. McElligott was elected Fire Commissioner in 2015.

4. On October 15, 2015, the Committee to Elect Pat McElligott (Campaign) filed one C-3 report, and one C-4 report manually on paper, prior to the 2015 general election being held. The C-4 report filed by the Campaign covered the period September 1 through September 30, 2015, and disclosed \$9,274 in contributions received and \$490 in expenditures made. The C-4 report was filed two days late, and did not disclose activities for the first 12 days of October.
5. The one C-3 report that was filed by the Campaign disclosed \$9,275 in monetary contributions that had been received during the period of September 1 through 28, 2015, from 18 contributors, that included a number of local fire fighter associations from around Washington State. The 18 contributions which should have been disclosed on three separate C-3 reports, were disclosed between 10 and 37 days late.
6. On July 12, 2017, Carol Wagner sent an email to PDC staff and attached copies of three signed paper filed C-4 reports and two C-3 reports, disclosing that the Campaign raised a total of \$10,395 in total contributions received, and made \$8,595 in expenditures, with a \$1,799 for a cash on hand balance.
7. The paper filed C-4 reports were filed between 550 and 639 days late, and included two expenditures made on October 8, 2015, to BDC Resources totaling \$4,347 to print and mail a flyer; (b) a \$2,781 expenditure made to BDC Resources on October 15, 2015, for a flyer; (c) a \$364 expenditure made to Mr. McElligott on October 15, 2015, reimbursing him for the first printing of campaign stickers; (d) a \$112 expenditure made to Mr. McElligott on November 23, 2015, reimbursing him for an ink cartridge; and (e) a \$500 expenditure to Ms. Wagner on December 1, 2015 for Campaign work.
8. The late filed C-3 reports disclosed that the Campaign received \$870 in monetary contributions that were received and deposited on October 16, 2015, from three local firefighter associations. The Campaign was required to have filed a C-3 report no later than October 19, 2015. The C-3 report disclosing the contributions was therefore filed 633 days late.
9. The late filed C-3 reports also disclosed that the Campaign received a \$250 monetary contribution that was received and deposited on November 2, 2015, from the Maple Valley local firefighter association.

10. The Campaign was required to have filed a C-3 report no later than December 10, 2015. The C-3 report disclosing the contribution was therefore filed 581 days late.
11. The Campaign made a \$364 expenditure on October 15, 2015, that when combined with other campaign expenditures resulted in the expenditures totals for the 2015 election being \$5,201, which put the Campaign over the \$5,000 electronic filing expenditure threshold. Based on that expenditure date, the Campaign exceeded \$5,000 in expenditures and was required to file its C-3 and C-4 reports electronically using the Online Reporting of Campaign Activity (ORCA) filing software or similar campaign finance filing software.
12. On September 7, 2017, Ms. Wagner electronically filed the C-3 and C-4 reports disclosing the contribution and expenditure activities for the 2015 election. The Campaign electronically filed the C-3 and C-4 reports for the 2015 election 694 days late.

IV. Law

RCW 42.17A.235 and **RCW 42.17A.240** requires candidates only appearing on the general election ballot that are under the Full Reporting option to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures, including 21-day and 7-day Pre-General C-4 reports, and C-3 reports on a weekly basis. C-4 reports are required to be filed 21 and 7 days before each election, and in the month following the election, regardless of the level of activity.

RCW 42.17A.245 requires candidates that expended five thousand dollars or more in the preceding election or expects to expend five thousand dollars or more in the current year shall file all contribution reports and expenditure reports required by this chapter by the electronic alternative provided by the commission.

Report of Investigation

I.

Background. Complaint and Allegations

- 1.1 On July 9, 2015, Patrick K McElligott filed a Candidate Registration (C-1 report) declaring his candidacy for East Pierce County Fire Commissioner in 2015, selecting the Full Reporting Option. **Exhibit #1.** The C-1 listed Bruce Baurichter as the Campaign Treasurer, and Carol Wagner as a person performing Ministerial duties for the Campaign. Mr. McElligott was elected Fire Commissioner in 2015.
- 1.2 Mr. McElligott was also a candidate for Pierce County Charter Review for Pierce County Council District 1, Position 2 in 2015, but was defeated in the general election, and he previously ran for East Pierce County Fire Commissioner position in 2011 and was defeated in the general election.
- 1.3 Mr. McElligott served as a Board Member of the Washington State Investment Board from 1997 through February of 2013, and filed annual Personal Financial Affairs Statements (F-1 reports) for those years. In addition, Mr. McElligott was also a registered lobbyist for the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters filing Monthly Lobbyist Expense reports (L-2 reports) through May of 1997 with the PDC.
- 1.4 On October 13, 2016, Ronald Scholz filed a complaint with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) alleging that Patrick K McElligott, a candidate East Pierce Fire Commissioner in 2011 and 2015, selected the Full Reporting Option but failed to file Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 report) and Campaign Summary Receipts and Expenditures reports (C-4 report) disclosing contribution and expenditure information for both elections. **Exhibit #2.** In addition, he alleged that Mr. McElligott failed to disclose the contribution or expenditure information either “in writing or in an electronic version.”
- 1.5 The allegations concerning the 2011 campaign were beyond the five-year statute of limitations and were not investigated by PDC staff.

II. **Detailed Findings**

- 2.1 Candidates under the Full Reporting option in 2015 were required to file weekly C-3 reports beginning Jun 1, 2015, and monthly C-4 reports by the 10th of each month disclosing contribution and expenditure activities incurred in the previous calendar month. Candidates that only appeared on the November 3, 2015 general election ballot, were required to file the following C-4 reports:
- A 21-day Pre-General Election C-4 report was due to be filed on October 13, 2015, covering the period September 1 through October 12, 2015.
 - A 7-day Pre-General Election C-4 report was due to be filed on October 27, 2015, covering the period October 13 through October 26, 2015.
 - A Post-General Election C-4 report was due to be filed by December 10, 2015, covering the period October 27 through November 30, 2015.

Failure to timely file C-3 and C-4 reports:

- 2.2 On October 15, 2015, the Committee to Elect Patrick K McElligott (Campaign) filed one Monetary Contributions report (C-3 report) and one Campaign Summary Receipts and Expenditures report (C-4 report) manually on paper, prior to the 2015 general election. **Exhibit #3.**
- 2.3 The Campaign filed a C-4 report covering the period September 1 through September 30, 2015, disclosing \$9,274 in contributions received and \$490 in expenditures made that included \$364 for stickers, and \$126 to purchase a mailing lists.
- 2.4 The Campaign filed a C-3 report disclosing \$9,275 in monetary contributions had been received during the period of September 1 through 28, 2015, from 18 contributors. The \$9,275 in monetary contributions received from 18 contributors should have been reported on three separate C-3 reports as detailed below:
1. The Campaign received \$2,575 in monetary contributions during the period September 1 through September 3, 2015, including: (1) a \$600 contribution from Active in Democracy; (2) three \$500 contributions received from local firefighter associations in Marysville, Bellingham, and Lacey; and (3) \$475 from three individuals. The Campaign was required to have filed a C-3 report no later than Tuesday, September 8, 2015. The C-3 report was filed 37 days late.
 2. The Campaign received \$5,250 in monetary contributions received on September 15, 2015, including: (1) a \$1,900 contribution from the Citizens for a Better Government (Puyallup); (2) two \$950 contributions from firefighter associations in East Pierce County, and Kent; (3) a \$500 contribution from a Spokane firefighter association; (4) and three \$250 contributions from firefighter associations in Olympia, Tumwater, and Vancouver. The Campaign was required to have filed a C-3 report no later than September 21, 2015. The C-3 report was filed 24 days late by the Campaign.

3. The Campaign received \$1,450 in monetary contributions on September 28, 2015, that included a \$950 contribution from a firefighter association in Issaquah, and \$500 contribution from a firefighter association in Renton. The Campaign was required to have filed a C-3 report no later than October 5, 2015. The C-3 report was filed 10 days late by the Campaign.
- 2.5 On October 17, 2016, more than 11 months after the November 3, 2015 general election was held, PDC staff notified Mr. McElligott about the complaint filed against his 2015 Campaign by email at “patmcelligott2015@gmail.com” which was the campaign email address listed on the C-1 report.
- 2.6 Since no response was received from Mr. McElligott, on April 20, 2017, PDC staff sent him another email to the email address he used to file his F-1 reports as a member of the State Investment Board, and attached a copy of the complaint. Mr. McElligott contacted PDC staff stating the 2015 campaign Gmail address was no longer being used by Mr. McElligott, so he did not receive the October 17, 2016 email concerning the complaint.
- 2.7 Mr. McElligott suggested that staff should contact Carol Wagner about the missing C-3 and C-4 reports, since she had filed the PDC reports during the 2015 Campaign. After being notified by PDC staff about the complaint and the missing reports, Ms. Wagner stated that she would be requesting the campaign bank statements from the 2015 election, and that it would likely take some time to receive them. She added that once she received and reconciled the bank statements, she would file the missing C-3 and C-4 reports.
- 2.8 On July 12, 2017, Ms. Wagner sent an email to PDC staff and attached copies of three signed paper filed C-4 reports and two C-3 reports, disclosing that the Campaign raised a total of \$10,395 in total contributions received, and made \$8,595 in expenditures, with a \$1,799 for a cash on hand balance. **Exhibit #4.** The paper filed C-4 reports were filed between 550 and 639 days late disclosed the following:
 1. A C-4 report was filed for the period October 1 through October 30, 2015, disclosing the Campaign received \$870 in new contributions that were deposited on October 16, 2015, and \$7,493 in expenditures that included: (a) two expenditures made on October 8, 2015, to BDC Resources totaling \$4,347 to print and mail a flyer; (b) a \$2,781 expenditure made to BDC Resources on October 15, 2015, for a flyer; and (c) a \$364 expenditure made to Mr. McElligott on October 15, 2015, reimbursing him for the first printing of campaign stickers.
 2. A C-4 report was filed for the period November 1 through November 30, 2015, disclosing the Campaign received \$250 in new contributions that were deposited on November 2, 2015, and \$112 in expenditures that included a \$112 expenditure made to Mr. McElligott on November 23, 2015, reimbursing him for an ink cartridge.
 3. A C-4 report was filed for the period December 1 through December 31, 2015, disclosing the Campaign received \$0 new contributions, made one \$500 expenditure to Ms. Wagner on December 1, 2015 for Campaign work.

2.9 The two-paper filed C-3 reports disclosed:

- The Campaign received \$870 in monetary contributions that were received and deposited on October 16, 2015, that included three contributions received from local firefighter associations in Kirkland (\$500); Seattle (\$270), and Aberdeen (\$100). The Campaign was required to have filed a C-3 report no later than October 19, 2015. The C-3 report was filed 633 days late.
- The Campaign received a \$250 monetary contribution that was received and deposited on November 2, 2015, from the Maple Valley local firefighter association. The Campaign was required to have filed a C-3 report no later than December 10, 2015. The C-3 report was filed 581 days late.

Failure to timely file C-3 and C-4 reports electronically:

- 2.10 After receiving and processing the emailed C-3 and C-4 reports, PDC staff informed Ms. Wagner that the C-3 and C-4 reports attached to the email should have been filed electronically since the Campaign had spent more than \$5,000. Ms. Wagner stated that she would file those reports electronically, but that it may take some time since she was having a personal issue with a family member.
- 2.11 The electronic filing requirements in RCW 42.17A.245 requires candidates expending or expecting to expend \$5,000 in the current election to comply with the law and file the C-3 and C-4 reports using the PDC Online Reporting of Campaign Activity (ORCA) filing software or similar campaign finance filing software.
- 2.12 The Campaign made a \$364 expenditure on October 15, 2015, that when combined with other campaign expenditures resulted in the expenditures totals for the 2015 election being \$5,201, which put the Campaign over the \$5,000 electronic filing expenditure threshold. Based on that expenditure date, the Campaign exceeded \$5,000 in expenditures and was required to file its C-3 and C-4 reports electronically using ORCA that day.
- 2.13 On September 7, 2017, Ms. Wagner electronically filed the C-3 and C-4 reports disclosing the contribution and expenditure activities for the 2015 election. The contribution and expenditure information was filed electronically 694 days late

III.
Scope

3.1 PDC staff reviewed the following documents:

- October 13, 2016, complaint filed by Ronald Scholz against Mr. McElligott.
- Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports) and Campaign Summary Contribution and Expenditure Reports (C-4 reports) filed by the Committee to Elect Patrick K McElligott.

- Query results for queries conducted of the PDC contribution and expenditure database.
- Correspondence and documents provided by Mr. McElligott, and telephone conversations and emails exchanged between PDC staff, Mr. McElligott and Ms. Wagner.

IV.
Statutes and Rules


- 4.1 **RCW 42.17A.235 and .240** requires candidates under the Full Reporting Option to timely file C-3 report and C-4 reports during the 2015 election disclosing contribution and expenditure activities.
- 4.2 **RCW 42.17A.245** requires candidates that expended five thousand dollars or more in the preceding election or expects to expend five thousand dollars or more in the current year shall file all contribution reports and expenditure reports required by this chapter by the electronic alternative provided by the commission.


