Each property description shall be followed by the name of the county in which the property is located. (ii) No modification will be necessary if the filer describes the real property using one of the alternatives in WAC 390-24-200, plus the name of the county. (iii) A modification will be required if the filer seeks some other means to describe reportable real property including the personal residence of the filer. The commission may consider a modification, for example, when the filer or his or her immediate family member has received a threat, has a no contact order, or presents a similar personal safety concern. 	Judge Rosen stated in previous requests, that he has been threatened by defendants, including one who threatened to shoot him with a shotgun. A police report was filed for this incident.
	Judge Rosen stated that in October 2014 he was threatened during a courtroom riot. The person has been identified and a trial has been scheduled for this year.
	Judge Rosen recalls being threatened one time in open court during 2017.
Other Issues	Judge Rosen disclosed the assessed value and creditor information for real estate property he owns in Washington State.
	Judge Rosen previously served as a Municipal Court Judge for the City of Seattle until the end of 2016. He was elected to the King County Superior Court with a term beginning January 2017.
