History	<p>Mr. Wampold served as a Fire Commissioner with Mason County Fire District 8 from 2004 until 2013. This district had less than 1,000 registered voters and did not require the commissioners to file the Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1).</p> <p>In 2014, Mason County Fire District 2 & 8 were dissolved and replaced by North Mason Regional Fire Authority. The new jurisdiction was large enough to require the F-1 to be submitted. Mr. Wampold filed his first required F-1 in 2015.</p>
Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mr. Wampold is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing reportable real estate with a value of over \$12,000 in which he held a personal financial interest during calendar year 2014. • Mr. Wampold stated that disclosing his real estate would allow others to take advantage of this information and potentially jeopardize his safety. In addition, he stated that as a minority owner of these properties he does not possess all of the information required to be disclosed and that creating a list of reportable real estate would take a substantial amount of time.
Other Issues	<p>Mr. Wampold stated that he is willing to disclose all information regarding properties in Mason County.</p> <p>Mr. Wampold stated that there is no conflict between his real estate and his duties as an elected official.</p>
