Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ms. Blake is requesting renewal of a reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing the business and governmental customers that paid \$12,000 or more during 2014 to Ecova. • Ms. Blake was a director of Ecova, a provider of energy efficiency and cost management programs and services for multi-site customers and utilities throughout North America, until the business was sold to a global energy company based in France on June 30, 2014. Its primary product lines include expense management services for utility, telecom, and lease needs as well as strategic energy management and efficiency services that include procurement, conservation, performance reporting, financial planning, and energy efficiency program management for commercial enterprises and utilities. • Ms. Blake stated that as a non-executive director she did not have access to the customers of Ecova. Since the sale of the business, she no longer has contact with anyone at the company who could provide the customer list if it was available.
Other Issues	Ms. Blake stated that the University of Washington did not conduct any business with and made no payments to Ecova during 2014.
Staff Recommendations	Approve renewal of the reporting modification with minor no change.
