

Dear PDC;

Joe A. Kunzler here. I will be on Amtrak Cascades and Trimet at the time of tomorrow's meeting, so this is 100% written. I wish to second Conner Edwards' request that you go with the penalty of \$75 not suspended and \$925 suspended on the condition that the non complying file the required reports and fully comply with the order to fill out their paperwork going forward. A 54% failure to compel compliance rate is absolutely, positively unacceptable - and a change is needed.

No PDC Watchdog you've heard from wants to put people other than Alex Tsimerman in a cardboard house, not one of us three watchdogs—Conner, Glen, or me.

But at a time, at a place where we have the personal information of every single complying candidate on your website for transparency we need to have clear incentives to comply. Fines help. Also helpful: When you accumulate over \$20,000 of fines the Attorney General's Office prosecutes. We need new laws next year to keep scofflaws off of the ballot and go after their Mercedes :-).

In closing: I am a bit fearful for a Jewish friend who is a public official and in good standing with the PDC. I don't like how I can call up her F-1 and find out where she and her family live at all. I wish there was a way to redact or restrict that info. At the very least, if we're going to put this kind of data of who volunteers for public life out on the Interwebs, then let's make sure it's necessary and noncompliance comes with consequences to reverse this 54% failure rate.
