Hi there PDC;

Joe Kunzler here. I'm going to be acute. Note the CCs this time, please.

Good, I got your attention.

You can expect a petition for rulemaking within a week asking that you tighten RCW 42.17A.555 and when the complaints are valid. Let's just say that today and yesterday, I saw a King County Councilmember use a broad definition and sack Tsimerman for the day. I also had a good dialogue with two municipal figures - one a mayor and another a city attorney - who want to wait until a candidate declares before using that tool. I think it's time we made everything VERY CLEAR as we go into a municipal election year, even if it limits my proclivity to throw the flag.

We need to have clear regulations here. With Tsimerman doing what he does, a clear standard is needed. This should be straightforward. A rulemaking task that will also hopefully speed up processing PDC complaints as it is apparent there is a significant backlog. Plus nobody wants to see a First Amendment test of RCW 42.17A.555.

Also, I expect the PDC to start figuring out how to close complaints. Several of my complaints are still open - 154729 and 160776 in particular.

Finally, I would like to try to give oral comments. Thanks!
