<b>Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mark Matteson is requesting a partial reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing his spouse's name.</li><li>• Mr. Matteson states that as professional staff his wife's name has no benefit by his position.</li><li>• Mr. Matteson states that his wife has been a victim of identify theft through a data breach and the uniqueness of her name is causing financial security or safety concerns.</li></ul>
<b>Other Issues</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mr. Matteson has agreed to recuse himself if a matter came before him involving a conflict of interest between interest between his personal interests and public duties of his position.</li><li>• Mr. Matteson's request could be granted for up to three years, as well as for the previously filed reports in accordance with RCW 42.17A.120(1).</li><li>• Mr. Matteson's records would be exempt from public disclosure if the Commission finds in accordance with <a href="#">RCW 42.17A.120</a> and <a href="#">WAC 390-28-080</a> that disclosure of such information would present a personal risk to a reasonable person.</li></ul>
